THE SERIES:

The Colonels lead the overall series 1-0 after last month's 31-28 victory in Richmond, Ky.

LAST MEETING:

The UCA had another fourth-quarter comeback against Eastern Kentucky but left too much time on the clock as the Colonels came back and scored the game-winning touchdown with 6 seconds left in a 31-28 victory at Roy Kidd Stadium in Richmond, Ky.

The Bears overcame deficits of 17-7 and 24-14, scoring two touchdowns in the final 4:35, including a 4-yard pass from Breylin Smith to Lujan Winningham (4:35) and a 1-yard keeper by Smith (1:21). But the Colonels drove 77 yards in eight plays and got a 21-yard touchdown pass from Dakota Allen to Matt Wilcox to win it.

Smith finished 30 of 45 passing (66.6%) for 320 yards and two touchdowns. Winningham caught nine passes for 103 yards and Tyler Hudson added seven for 106 yards, including an 11-yard TD reception in the second quarter. A combination of two EKU quarterbacks completed 24 of 34 for 301 yards and 3 touchdowns.

UCA's defense, which forced six turnovers and had 7 sacks and 13 tackles for loss the previous week vs. Missouri State, forced a pair of fumbles (Cameron Godfrey, Leandre Rucks recoveries) but had just 2 TFLs and zero sacks. EKU finished with 460 yards of total offense while UCA had 419.

LAST GAME:

The Bears spotted the Division II Missouri Western Griffons a 7-0 lead then scored the next 45 points en route to a 52-10 victory on Halloween afternoon at Estes Stadium.

The Bears got five touchdown passes from junior QB Breylin Smith, tying his career high, and the Bears rushed for a season-high 235 yards (58 more than previous high). Junior Lujan Winningham and sophomore Tyler Hudson each caught two touchdown passes, with Hudson going 4 for 137. Sophomore TE Austin Eldridge caught his first career TD pass, while redshirt freshman RB Marshun Douglas had his first career rushing TD (67 yards). Sophomore DE Logan Jessup also had his first career TD with a 26-yard fumble recovery.

UCA's defense held MWSU to 198 yards of total offense (3.4 yards per

play) while the Bears piled up a season-high 539 yards (8.6 per play).

NEXT GAME:

UCA will close out the 2020 season with a visit to Lafayette, La., to take on the Top 25 Louisiana Rajin Cajuns at 1 p.m. next Saturday at 1 p.m. on ESPN+.

The Bears and Rajin Cajuns will be meeting for the first time. It will be UCA's third matchup with an FBS team this season, a program high since moving to FCS in 2006.

REESE'S SENIOR BOWL:

UCA senior CB Robert Rochell received his invite to the 2021 Reese's Senior Bowl on Tuesday. He will be the third UCA Bear since 2009 to play in the prestigious All-Star game, joining his head coach Nathan Brown (2009) and wide receiver Dezmin Lewis (2015).



The 72nd annual game will be played Saturday, Jan. 30 at 1:30 p.m. at Hancock Whitney Stadium in Mobile, Ala. It will be televised on the NFL Network.

Rochelle, a 6-foot-2-, 185-pounder from Shreveport, La. (Fair Park HS), is an All-American and first-team All-Southland Conference selection and is a three-year starter for the Bears. He has 10 career interceptions, 28 career pass breakups and 101 career tackles.

This season, despite missing two games with an injury, he has 24 tackles, 3 pass break ups, a forced fumble and a fumble recovery returned for a 35-yard touchdown against UAB.

THE SENIORS:

UCA will officially recognize 20 seniors prior to Saturday's final home game. The senior class of 2020 has combined to win 29 games, has won a pair of Southland conference championships and has made two appearances in the FCS Playoffs.

The seniors, who have all been granted another year of eligibility by the NCAA due to Covid-19, include:

wide receivers Dwight Blakey and Tobias Enlow; defensive backs Robert Rochell, Leandre Rucks, Chris Kershner, Davis Harrison and Justin Meadows; tight ends Sam Camargo, Josh Nix and Jack Short; running back Kierre Crossley; linebackers DJ Reed, Trenton Dunn and Victor Hill; snapper/holder Will Siler; defensive linemen JW Jones, Austin Norris, A'Javius Brown and Nathan Grant, and offensive lineman Toby Sanderson.

THE POLLS:

UCA finished the 2019 regular season ranked No. 11 both the STATS FCS final and FCS Coaches' final polls. Fellow Southland Conference teams Nicholls, Southeastern Louisiana and Sam Houston State were also ranked in the final polls. Austin Peay was 10th and 13th.

UCA is No. 11 in the 2020 STATS FCS preseason poll and No. 10 in the Hero Sports poll.

EFFICIENCY:

Junior WR Lujan Winningham's two touchdown receptions against Missouri Western gave him 11 for the season out of 32 total receptions.

His 11 TDs leads the FCS in both receiving TDs and overall TDs. ECU's Keyion Dixon is fourth with five. For his career, Winningham now has 94 receptions for 1,417 yards and 20 touchdowns, which is tied for fourth in UCA history (Desmond Smith, Landon Trusty). The 11 TD receptions this season tops his career best of eight from last year, when he missed four games with a broken arm, and is tied for third (Marquez Branson) in UCA history. The school single-season record is 14 by Ronnie Mallett (1979).

COMEBACK KIDS:

The Bears recorded their seventh come-from-behind victory in the last 14 games in the 2020 season opener vs. APSU, and then made it eight comebacks in the win over Missouri State on Sept. 26. Another rally gave UCA at 33-24 win over MSU on Oct. 10 for its ninth comeback victory over the past two seasons.

The Bears trailed APSU 17-16 with 1:40 remaining before winning 24-17 with a 10-yard touchdown pass from Breylin Smith to Lujan Winningham with 34 seconds left. UCA outscored APSU 18-7 in the second half.

Against MSU, the Bears trailed 20-7 midway through the third quarter before scoring 20 unanswered points to win 27-20. In the second meeting with MSU last Saturday, UCA was down 24-17 at halftime on the road, but outscored the home Bears 16-0 in the second half.

UCA had six comeback victories a year ago, including another APSU win on the road. The Bears outscored their opponents 217-130 in the second half in 2019. The numbers are even more impressive in the fourth quarter, with UCA winning that period 134-70.

In the 2020 season opener, UCA topped APSU 18-7 in the second half, scoring the game-winning TD with 34 seconds remaining.

THE GAUNTLET:

With the Southland Conference voting to shift fall 2020 sports to the spring semester, it left open the option for schools to play a selection of non-conference games. UCA took that one step further, putting together a formidable 10-game slate, beginning Aug. 29 against Austin Peay, the only game that was on the Bears' original schedule.

UCA, which lost a guarantee game at SEC Missouri when the SEC voted to play only conference games, added three FBS programs to the schedule, a first for a single season. UCA will take on UAB (Sept. 3) at Legion Field in Birmingham, Ala. in-state rival Arkansas State (Oct. 10) in Jonesboro, Ark., and close the season at Louisiana-Lafayette (Nov. 21) in Lafayette, La.

UCA was scheduled to renew its rivalry with ASU next season in Jonesboro, but added a matchup this year as well. The schools are located just two hours apart. The Bears won the last meeting 28-23 in 2016. The game was originally scheduled for Sept. 19 but was moved to Oct. 10 because ASU could not field a full two-deep due to COVID-19 issues.

UCA also scheduled rare home-and-home series with Missouri State (Sept. 26 in Conway, Oct. 17 in Springfield, Mo.) and vs. Eastern Kentucky (Oct. 10 in Richmond, Ky./Oct. 31 in Conway). The exclamation point was added to the schedule when UCA released a three-game series with three-time defending FCS national champion (and eight of last nine) North Dakota State. The Bears and Bison will meet on Oct. 3 at the Fargodome in Fargo, N.D. Ironically, the Bison are playing just one game this fall after the Missouri Valley Football Conference (MVFC) also shifted fall sports to the spring. UCA-NDSU will meet again in Fargo in 2023 and in Conway in 2025.

UCA will be facing five programs (EKU, UAB, Louisiana, Missouri Western, NDSU) for the first time. Louisiana is receiving votes in the Top 25 polls. The Rajin Cajuns are 4-1 with a win over No. 23 Iowa State. UAB is 4-2 with the only losses to Miami and Louisiana. Arkansas State has a win over Top 25 Kansas State.

The Bears will face a unique trip in the first two weeks of the 2020 season. UCA travels to Montgomery to face Austin Peay on Saturday (Aug. 29) and rather than return to Conway, will instead stay in Birmingham in preparation for Thursday night's matchup at UAB.

Also, UCA will only have three home games this fall on "The Stripes" at First Security Field at Estes Stadium. The APSU game was originally in Conway but was moved to accommodate the Guardian Credit Union FCS Kickoff in Montgomery, Ala. UCA added Missouri Western to the schedule on Oct. 31.

DOUBLING UP:

The Bears will play two opponents (Missouri State & Eastern Kentucky) home and home this season. The last time UCA played the same team twice in a season was 2005 when UCA beat North Alabama 29-26 in double overtime in the Gulf South Conference regular-season game in Conway, then lost to UNA 41-38 in overtime in the NCAA Division II quarterfinals, also at Estes Stadium.

The last time UCA repeated an opponent during the regular season was

all the way back in 1957 when the Bears faced four teams (Ouachita Baptist, Henderson State, Ozarks, Arkansas A&M) twice each during the NAIA era.

CLIMBING THE CHARTS:

Junior QB Breylin Smith's three touchdown passes vs. UAB gave him 43 for his career, moving him past UCA receivers coach Ryan Howard (2011-14) and Wynrick Smothers (2010-13), who had 42 touchdowns each. His one TD pass vs. Missouri State tied him with Nathan Dick (2009-11) with 44. Three more against NDSU pushed Smith to 47 and into 5th place, just one TD pass behind fourth-place Zak Clark (48, 2002, 2004). Two more against Arkansas State put him at 49 and in fourth place. Two more vs. Missouri State gave him 51 and two at Eastern Kentucky made it 53. The five vs. Missouri Western tied his career high and puts him at 58 and fourth overall.

Smith previously passed UCA offensive coordinator Ken Collums (39, 1991-94). Head coach Nathan Brown (2005-08) owns the school record with 100 TD passes. Hayden Hildebrand (2013-17) is second with 62. Third is Randy Huffstickler (61, 1978-81).

Smith's career passing yards is now at 6,652, just the fourth QB in UCA history to surpass 6,000 yards. He fourth behind third-place Huffstickler (7,360). Brown owns the overall record at 10,558 yards.

Smith is also third in career pass attempts (919) and third in career pass completions (570).

Smith set a new school single-season passing mark last season with 3,704 yards and tied the school record with 32 touchdown passes. He completed 316 of 490 passes (64.5 percent) and averaged 284.9 passing yards per game with a 143.01 efficiency rate.

Smith broke the mark of 3,275 held by Nathan Dick (2011). Brown is third (3,206) and seventh (3,084) on that list, and is UCA's career leader with 10,558 yards and 100 touchdowns.

Smith also set school marks for single-season attempts (490) and completions (316).

Freshman WR Tyler Hudson tied for 2nd in school history with 12 touchdown receptions last season. He tied Aaron Fairouz (2005), trailing only Ronnie Mallett (14 in 1979).

STEPPING UP:

Sophomore DE Logan Jessup was not on the UCA two-deep to start the season but turned in one of the team's best defensive games of the year on Oct. 17 at Missouri State.

Jessup, a 6-foot-3, 275-pounder from Wynne, Ark., had 3.5 sacks and 4.5 tackles for loss among his six tackles. The 3.5 sacks ties the school record held by Jonathan Woodard (vs. SFA in 2014). His 4.5 tackles for loss was just short of tying the school mark of 5.0 held by Icsom Jones (vs. Ouachita Baptist in 2003). As a team, UCA recorded 7 sacks and 13 TFLs.

LAST SEASON:

The Bears won a share of the Southland Conference title, finishing 7-2 in league play (tied with Nicholls State). UCA also recorded a 35-28 win over FBS Western Kentucky, one over only three FCS teams to record a victory over an FBS team in 2019. The Bears outscored the Hilltoppers 21-0 in the fourth quarter to overcome a 28-14 deficit on the road in Bowling Green, Ky.

The Bears, who finished 9-4 overall, earned their fifth appearance in the FCS Playoffs since moving to NCAA Division I in 2006 (becoming eligible in 2010). UCA earned the No. 8 national seed and a first-round bye before hosting Illinois State in the second round on "The Stripes" at Estes Stadium. The Redbirds beat the Bears 24-14.

TROPHY TIME:

The Bears won two trophies last season, claiming a share of the Southland Conference championship (with Nicholls) and also beating McNeese State for the "Red Beans & Rice" traveling trophy.

SOUTHLAND PLANS:

Four Southland Conference programs will play games in the fall semester, including UCA, Stephen F. Austin, Abilene Christian and Houston Baptist.

UCA has 10 games scheduled, while SFA also has 10 games on its current schedule with the late addition of Memphis, and ACU has six. HBU has a four-game fall schedule. SFA, UCA and HBU share one common opponent in Eastern Kentucky, a member of the Ohio Valley Conference. UCA and ECU will play twice.

The league voted on Aug. 13 to move all fall sports to the spring semester. UCA will also compete in the remainder of its fall sports, volleyball, men's and women's soccer and men's and women's cross country, this semester. The SLC announced its spring schedule on Tuesday, with each of the seven participating teams playing six games (three home, three away) from Feb. 20 to April 10.

ALL-SLC / ALL-AMERICA:

The Bears led the league with 13 All-Southland Conference picks last season, and had a league-high 13 selections on the 2020 preseason All-SLC team released this summer. UCA also had the SLC Freshman of the Year in WR Tyler Hudson (Spring, Texas) last season.

The Bears had three first-team selections (WR Lujan Winningham, OL Hunter Watts (senior), CB Robert Rochell), six second-teamers were Hudson, QB Breylin Smith, RB Carlos Blackman (senior), DE Nathan Grant, S Juan Jackson (senior) and KR Cameron Myers. The four third-team selections were C Toby Sanderson, OL Jaylen Hendrix, PK Hayden Ray and LB T.J. Campbell.

UCA also had four underclassmen named All-Americans as Smith, Hendrix Hudson and offensive lineman Parker Ray earned either Freshman or Sophomore honors from Hero Sports. Smith was a first-team sophomore selection and Hendrix was an honorable mention. Hudson and Ray were both first-team on the freshman team.

Rochell, a 6-foot-2, 176-pound junior cornerback from Shreveport, La. (Fair Park High School) was named a first-team All-American by the American Football Coaches Association (AFCA) and was a third-team selection by STATS FCS.

HOME & SEASON OPENERS:

The Bears are tied with North Dakota State for the second-longest winning streak in home opening games in the FCS. Both have won 22 straight home openers. North Dakota holds the top mark with 33 straight home opener wins.

UCA's win over Missouri State on Sept. 26 was No. 22. Ironically, NDSU's 22nd win was over UCA last Saturday.

UCA beat Abilene Christian 31-30 on Sept. 14, 2019 in last season's home opener. In season openers since moving to NCAA Division I in 2006, the Bears have a 9-7 record. Six of those seven losses were to FBS teams.

HISTORIC VENUES:

UCA's first two games of the 2020 season were hosted by historic venues in the Cramton Bowl in Montgomery, Ala., and Legion Field in Birmingham, Ala.

The Cramton Bowl was built as a baseball stadium in 1022 and is named for Fred J. Cramton, a local businessman who donated the land on which the stadium is built. The stadium is well known for hosting the annual Blue-Gray Football Classic, an college football all-star game which was held there each December from 1938 until 2001.

Legion Field opened in 1927 and served as one of two home field sfor the Alabama Crimson Tide and the site of annual Iron Bowl between Alabama and Auburn from 1948 to 1988. Alabama played some home games there until 2003.

The Fargodome, where UCA will face NDSU in October, is known as one of the most iconic venues at the FCS level. This will officially be UCA's first indoor football game in school history for a program that began playing in 1908.

CATCHING UP:

UCA's top two receivers, junior Lujan Wunningham and sophomore Tyler Hudson combined for 105 receptions that went for 1,789 yards and 20 touchdowns a year ago. Both earned All-Southland Conference and underclassmen All-America honors.

Combine them with junior Brandon Myers, who missed last season with injury, and you have a trio that has now combined for 231 catches for 3,854 yards and 48 touchdowns. Myers has 40 career receptions for 771 yards and 10 touchdowns but has not played yet this season after dislocating his kneecap and missing the entire 2019 season.

HOME SWEET HOME:

The Bears will host just three regular-season games this season at First Security Field at Estes Stadium, also know as "The Stripes".

The Bears went 4-2 at home last season and 4-1 the previous year.

UCA, which was 5-1 at home in 2016 and 2017 and 3-2 in 2018, is entering its 10th season on "The Stripes" and has a 41-11 record since the installation of the unique purple and gray striped playing surface.

Through two+ seasons on the turf, the Bears were a perfect 11-0 on "The Stripes." Losses to McNeese State and Southeastern Louisiana in 2013 were the first two since the turf went down in 2011. The Bears did close out that season at home with a rousing 49-31 victory over No. 9 Sam Houston.

Over the past 12 seasons since moving to Division I, UCA's home record is 63-17, including 7-0 in 2008, 5-0 in 2011 and 6-0 in 2012. The 63 home victories is the most of any SLC team over that time period.

UCA was the last team in the Southland Conference to change from natural grass to artificial turf in 2011.

vs. FBS:

UCA was one of just three FCS programs to record a victory over an FBS team last season (in 111 matchups), and was also the first to accomplish it. UCA went on the road and beat Western Kentucky 35-28 _ thanks to a 21-0 fourth quarter _ in Week 1 in Bowling Green, Ky.

The Bears are now 3-14 against FBS teams. UCA beat in-state rival Arkansas State 28-23 in Jonesboro in 2016 for its second win. UCA's first win over an FBS opponent was against the same Western Kentucky team in 2009.

UCA has had close calls over the years, losing 25-20 to Hawaii in 2009 after leading with two minutes remaining, 48-42 in overtime to Louisiana Tech in 2011, 38-24 at Colorado in 2013 and 42-35 at Texas Tech in 2014. The Bears also trailed Oklahoma State 17-8 late in the third quarter of a 32-8 loss in 2015. UCA also led Ole Miss 20-14 at halftime of a 49-27 loss in 2012 in Oxford, Miss. The Bears lost 45-35 to UAB two weeks ago.

MORE SLC HONORS:

The Bears took home five of the first nine weekly Southland Conference individual honors last season and won eight total for the 2019 season.

UCA won two of the three SLC Player of the Week awards in Week 1. Sophomore WR Lujan Wunningham was named the Offensive Player of the Week, while junior CB Robert Rochell was the Defensive Player of the Week.

Wunningham (Humble, Texas) caught 8 passes for 222 yards and three touchdowns to lead the UCA offense. Rochell (Shreveport, La.) had seven tackles, two pass breakups and a key second-quarter interception with the Bears trailing 14-0.

Wunningham repeated the next week after catching eight passes for 136 yards and two fourth-quarter touchdowns in UCA's 24-16 come-from-behind win at Austin Peay. Junior safety/nickel Davis Harrison won the defensive award with 7 tackles, including one for a loss. He made two tackles on APSU's final drive that ended in a Robert Rochell interception that preserved the victory.

Junior PK Hayden Ray won the Special Teams Player of the Week award after the ACU game. Ray was perfect, hitting 3 of 3 field goals and 2 of 2 PATs, including the game-winner with 1:30 left in the game.

Ray took home the award again after the McNeese game after going 4 for 4 on field goals (34, 39, 25, 39) and 4 of 4 on PATs to account for 16 of UCA's 40 points.

Sophomore QB Breylin Smith won the offensive award after the SHSU game where he completed 24 of 43 for 405 yards and 4 touchdowns, and again after the Lamar win when he completed 30 of 37 for 434 yards and four touchdowns and added a rushing TD.

The Bears will not take home any SLC Player of the Week honors this season with the league moving the conference football season to the spring semester.

STATISTICALLY SPEAKING:

UCA QB Breylin Smith finished 5th in the nation last year in passing yards with 3,704. He was also tied for 6th in passing TDs (32) and 14th in completion percentage (64.5%).

WR Tyler Hudson tied for 11th in FCS in receiving touchdowns with 12. PK Hayden Ray was second in field goal percentage (15 of 17, 88.3%). CB Robert Rochell was ninth in passes defended with 18 (5 INT, 13 PBU).

FCS PLAYOFF HISTORY:

UCA beat Tennessee Tech in the first round in 2011 (34-14 in Cookeville, Tenn.), then lost to Montana 41-14 in Missoula.

In 2012, the Bears lost their opening game at Georgia Southern 24-16 in Statesboro, Ga. UCA hosted Illinois State in 2016 in the first round and won 31-24 before losing 31-14 at Eastern Washington in Cheney, Wash.

UCA was also nationally seeded in 2017 and hosted New Hampshire in the second round but lost 21-15.

BEAR TRACKS...

- Logan Jessup's 26-yard fumble return for a TD vs. Missouri Western was UCA's second of the season, following Robert Rochell's 35-yarder vs. UAB.
- Three Bears had their first career TDs vs. Missouri Western (DE Logan Jessup, TE Austin Eldridge, RB Marshun Douglas).
- The 52 points scored vs. MWSU was the most since a 52-35 win over Incarnate Word last season (11/22/19).
- The Bears played six of their first seven games on the road in 2020.
- The Bears are a +5 in turnover margin this season with 22 gained (9 INT, 13 FBL) and 17 lost (10 INT, 7 FBL).

Cameron Godfrey and DeAndre Lamont both have 2 INTs, while Logan Jessup has 2 fumble recoveries and Darin Davenport 3 forced fumbles. The 13 fumble recoveries leads all of FCS.

- In the two games vs. Missouri State this season (both wins), UCA recorded 16.0 sacks, 29 tackles for loss and forced 10 turnovers.

- DeAndre Lamont's 35-yard interception return vs. Missouri State (Oct. 10) was the first for UCA since Juan Jackson returned one 43 yards vs. Incarnate Word on 11/11/17.
- Redshirt freshman RB Marshun Douglas's TD pass to Lujuan Winningham vs. ASU was the first by a non-quarterback since RB Carlos Blackman had one against Hawaii last season (Sept. 21). Blackman also tossed one in the 2019 season-opening win over Western Kentucky, going 2 for 2 for 84 yards and 2 TDs for the year.

- Lujan Hudson's punt return for a TD vs. ASU was the most since Tyler Hudson caught 3 vs. Incarnate Word last season (Nov. 22), and tied his own career best of 3 vs. Western Kentucky last season (Aug. 29).

- The 177 yards of total offense (and 10 first down) by the Bears against Missouri State on Sept. 26. was their lowest total in the NCAA Division I era (beginning in 2006). The previous low was 217 yards in a 42-37 loss at Stephen F. Austin on Sept. 29, 2012 in a monsoon in Nacogdoches, Texas.

The total was the lowest overall for the Bears since they put up 196 yards in a 31-7 win over Southern Arkansas on Sept. 10, 2005 at Estes Stadium back in the NCAA Division II era.

QB Breylin Smith's 79 passing yards and nine completions vs. Missouri State (first meeting) were both career lows in games he was the primary quarterback.

- The Bears had a 23-day break between their game at UAB (Sept. 3) and at home with Missouri State (Sept. 26) due to an open date and Covid-19 issues at Arkansas State.

- Tyler Hudson's punt return for a TD vs. Missouri State was UCA's first since Tremor Smith had one vs. Arkansas State in 2016.

- Two of UCA's three FBS opponents on this year's schedule knocked off Big 12 teams on Sept. 12. ASU beat Kansas State 35-31 and Louisiana downed Top 25 Iowa State 31-14.
- UCA QB Breylin Smith has thrown at least one TD pass in 16 of the 19 games he has started at UCA, with a high of 5 vs. Incarnate Word in 2019.

- Robert Rochell's 35-yard fumble return for a touchdown against UAB was UCA's first since Reggio Dean returned one six yards for a touchdown against Houston Baptist on 10/6/18. Dre Matthews added another one (30 yards) vs. Missouri State on Sept. 26.

- 18 different players caught passes for the Bears last season, including five players with at least 20 receptions. Nine different players had TD receptions. So far this season, 17 different players have caught passes, but only five have TD receptions. Six different TE's have caught passes this season.

- There are 46 Bears from Arkansas on the roster, the most of any state and more than double No. 2 Texas (21).

- Redshirt freshman QB Luke Hales threw five touchdown passes twice in 2018 (HBU, NSU) while subbing for injured Breylin Smith. He is just the sixth UCA quarterback to throw at least five TDs in a game, and only the fourth to do it multiple times. One of those is head coach Nathan Brown, who was joined by Breylin Smith in the 2019 regular-season finale at UIW the only other ones in the FCS era.

- UCA's group of 14 seniors last year won 35 games over the past four years, including a pair of 10-win seasons and won a share of their second Southland Conference championship and a third berth in the FCS Playoffs.

- In consecutive games vs. Lamar and SHSU last season, sophomore QB Breylin Smith completed 54 of 80 passes (67.5%) for 839 yards and 8 touchdowns with just 1 interception. His efficiency rating in those two games was 186.1 and his total offense average was 408.0.

- UCA had 9 different leading tacklers in its 13 games last season. Seven of those are returning in 2020, including Cameron Godfrey (2), Malik Wilson, Darin Davenport, Dre Matthews, Leandre Rucks, Davis Harrison and T.J. Campbell.

- Two players were named to FCS watch lists last season. QB Breylin Smith was on the Walter Payton Award Watch list. WR Tyler Hudson was on the Jerry Rice Award watch list.
- UCA overcame three 14-point deficits in the win over FBS Western Kentucky last season, trailing 14-0, 21-7 and 28-14.

- UCA's victory over Western Kentucky last season was the 100th since moving to NCAA Division I in 2006. The Bears are 111-56 (66.4%) in the FCS era.

- UCA was named the national FCS Team of the Week by STATS FCS after the 35-28 win over Western Kentucky. Sophomore WR Lujuan Winningham was named the national Player of the Week by College Sports Madness.

- The Bears had their ninth winning season in the past 10 last year. UCA's last losing season was 2009 (under head coach Clint Conque) when the Bears went 5-7, losing their last five games of the year after starting out 5-2. That was just one year after a 10-2 season in 2008. UCA was .500 (6-6) in 2014.

- UCA has recorded 39 winning seasons in the past 45 years, dating back to 1973. UCA tied the school record with 11 victories in 2005, and won 10 games in both 2016 and 2017.

PROFESSIONAL BEARS:

The Bears have two players on NFL rosters for the 2019 season. Safety George Odum, the 2017 Southland Conference Defensive Player of the Year, is

in his third season with the Indianapolis Colts. He finished 2017 with 35 tackles and one interception, starting two games for the Colts. He added 37 tackles (30 solos) in 2019.

Cornerback/kick returner Tremor Smith spent last season with the Green Bay Packers after a year with the Kansas City Chiefs. Smith, second in the SLC in interceptions with 5 in 2017 and a 6th-round draftee, finished his first year with the Chiefs with 33 kick returns for 886 yards, with a long of 97 yards and a 26.9-yard average in 2018. He is now also with the Colts as of Summer 2020.

COACHING QBs:

Head Coach Nathan Brown's coaching staff features three former UCA quarterbacks, including himself, and three UCA Sports Hall of Famers.

Brown (2005-08) holds nearly every passing record at UCA, throwing for 100 touchdowns and 10,558 yards in his career.

Offensive coordinator Ken Collums (1991-94) holds the distinction as the only one of the three to win a national championship, as he led the Bears to the NAIA national title as a freshman in 1991. He came back to UCA two years ago after a head coaching stint at Abilene Christian.

Tight ends coach Ryan Howard (2011-14) is in his fifth year on the staff and second coaching wide receivers and special teams. He was UCA's leading passer in 2013 and 2014. Those three quarterbacks combined to pass for 20,450 yards and 181 touchdowns in their UCA careers.

The UCA Sports Hall of Fame members on staff are Brown (Class of 2016), Collums (2018) and Brooks Hollingsworth (2011), the Bears' assistant head coach and tight ends coach, who is in his fifth stint at UCA.

BEING OFFENSIVE:

The Bears' offense has been consistently prolific during their time in the Southland, averaging close to 5,000 yards per season since joining the league in 2006. The high was 5,584 in 2017. They topped 5,000 yards of total offense six times, including four of the past six years.

UCA has averaged nearly 3,100 passing yards per season, with a high of 3,979 in 2013. The Bears have averaged 26 passing touchdowns over that time period (high of 34 in 2011) and have topped the 3,000-yard passing mark nine times in 13 seasons.

WINNING WAYS:

UCA enters the 2020 season as the winningest college football team in the state of Arkansas since 2001. Their best outing was an 11-3 record back in 2005 when the Bears reached the quarterfinal round of the NCAA Division II Playoffs and tied the school record for victories. They won 10 Division I games last year en route to a 10-3 record in 2016, including an FCS Playoff victory vs. Illinois State, and had another 10-2 season in 2017.

SCORING STREAK:

The Bears had a streak of 274 games in which they scored broken with the shutout loss to Southeastern Louisiana on Nov. 9, 2019. The last shutout overall prior to that was when UCA lost 19-0 at Delta State in 1995. The last shutout at home was 1986 prior to that was against East Central Oklahoma in the NAIA days. The Bears have now scored in 391 of their last 393 games, dating back to 1986.

CONFERENCE AFFILIATION:

The Bears have been members of the Southland Conference since they moved to Division I FCS in 2006. UCA's record in SLC games is officially 64-24. That includes an 9-0 record in 2017, 8-1 in 2016, 6-1 records in 2008, 2011 and 2012 and a 7-2 mark in 2015. The Bears also beat two SLC teams (Sam Houston & S.F. Austin) in their first year in the league when they did not play a full league schedule. UCA won an "unofficial" SLC title (due to transition rules) in 2008, was co-champion in 2012 and outright champs in 2017.

FAMOUS ALUMS:

UCA's most famous football alumnus is Monte Coleman, who played 16 seasons (1979-94) with the Washington Redskins and won three Super Bowl titles. Coleman, from Pine Bluff, Ark., was a linebacker and safety at UCA from 1975-78 and is the former head football coach at Arkansas-Pine Bluff.

UCA's most famous non-football alum is Scottie Pippen, a six-time NBA champion and two-time Olympic Dream Teamer. Pippen grew up in tiny Hamburg, Ark. in the SE Arkansas delta region and played at UCA from 1983-87 as

HEAD COACH NATHAN BROWN

The most prolific quarterback in University of Central Arkansas history became the 20th head coach of the program in December 2017 when Nathan Brown was hired to replace Steve Campbell.



Brown, a 2016 inductee in the UCA Sports Hall of Fame in his first year of eligibility, spent the previous four years (2014-17) as the Bears' offensive coordinator on teams that went 33-15 (.688), including 20-5 (.800) in 2016-17 and had the most efficient passing offense in the FCS in 2017.

Brown, a native of Russellville, Ark., led the Bears to a 6-5 mark in his first season as head coach. Of the five losses by the Bears, two were by three or less points, including one in overtime. UCA finished 5-4 in Southland Conference play.

The Bears had the No. 4 scoring offense in the league, the No. 2 rushing defense and the No. 3 scoring defense.

Brown's offenses totaled 20,969 yards and averaged 437 yards per game during his years as offensive coordinator, while having three different quarterbacks being named first-team All-Southland Conference (Hayden Hildebrand 2017, Wynrick Smothers 2012, Nathan Dick 2011). Hildebrand was the SLC Player of the Year while Smothers was the SLC Offensive

Player of the Year.

During his years as quarterbacks coach at UCA, the Bears' quarterbacks averaged 3,211 passing yards per season, eclipsing the 3,000-yard yard plateau six times, for a total of 25,691 yards. With Brown as the Bears' offensive coordinator, UCA had 17 All-SLC offensive first or second team selections, including a Freshman, Player and two Offensive Linemen of the Year selections. The Bears ranked in the Top 10 in FCS scoring three times in four years, and ranked seventh in the country in total offense in 2017.

Brown coached four of the top six total offense seasons in school history, and he was the starting quarterback for the other two seasons. He also played or coached in seven of the top 10 passing offensive seasons in program history. Brown has been a part of three Southland Conference championships, one as player in 2008 and two as an assistant coach in 2012 and 2017.

Brown has been a part of all four of UCA's NCAA postseason playoff victories, two as a player (Division II) and two as a coach (FCS).

Equally as impressive as his coaching credentials are his numbers from his playing days at UCA. Brown was a three-time All-American who threw for 10,558 yards and 100 touchdowns in his career, both records for a collegiate quarterback in the state of Arkansas. The Bears went 30-10 with Brown as the starting quarterback.

He was the SLC Offensive Player of the Year in 2007 and the SLC Player of the Year in 2008, when he was also a Walter Payton Award finalist. Brown also

owns school records for touchdown passes in a game (7) and most yards of total offense (490).

Before UCA moved to Division I in 2006, Brown was named the Gulf South Conference Freshman of the year in 2005.

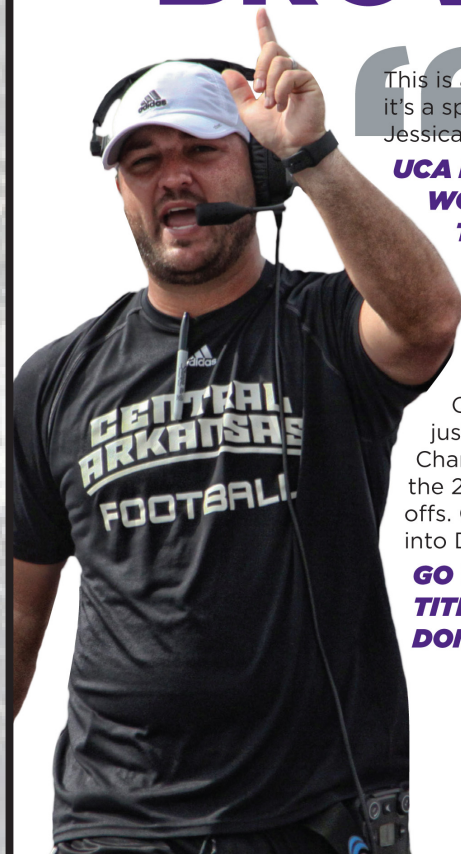
Brown was UCA's first player to receive an invitation to the Senior Bowl All-Star game in the NCAA Division I era and was the leading passer in the 2009 game. He was also selected for the East-West Shrine Game that same year. He was a free-agent signee of both the Jacksonville Jaguars and New Orleans Saints.

Brown received his bachelor's degree in business education from the University of Central Arkansas in 2009 after graduating from Russellville High School in 2004.

He has a wife, Jessica (also a UCA graduate), daughter Rylee and
