The Bears and Governors will be meeting for just the fourth time. UCA leads the series 3-0, with all games played away from Conway.

LAST MEETING:

The Bears and Governors met in the Guardian Credit Union FCS Kickoff on Aug. 29, 2020 to open the covid-19 season, with UCA winning 24-17 at the Cramton Bowl in Montgomery, Ala.

The Bears, in front of an ESPN audience, got a 10-yard touchdown pass from Breylin Smith to Lujuan Winningham with just 34 seconds left to win it. APSU had taken a 17-16 lead with 1:40 remaining on a 1-yard run by QB Jeremy Oatsvall.

UCA freshman DB Tamuarion Wilson sealed the victory with an interception at the UCA 6 as time expired.

The Bears finished with 460 yards of total offense while holding the Governors to 333 yards. Smith completed 26 of 49 passes for 283 yards, while TB Kierre Crossley rushed 121 times for 110 yards (9.2 avg.), including a 34-yard touchdown. Winningham caught six passes for 80 yards.

Hayden Ray kicked field goals of 30, 27 and 32 yards for UCA, which fell behind 10-0 early in the second quarter.

UCA beat APŚU in similar fashion the previous year, with Smith hitting Winningham twice in the fourth quarter for touchdowns, and Robert Rochell sealing it with an interception.

LAST WEEK:

The Bears struggled to run the ball last Saturday in a 35-27 loss to the Southeast Missouri Redhawks at Houck Stadium in Cape Girardeau, Mo.

2008, 2012, 2017, 2019 SLC Champions 126 All-Americans 65 NCAA All-Academic picks UCA was held to just 16 rushing yards after entering the game averaging 143 yards a game on the ground. UCA's leading rusher Darius Hale, the reigning ASUN Freshman of the Year, had 12 carries for 24 yards and one touchdown.

Transfer QB Will McElvain completed 19 of 30 passes for a season-high 284 yards but no touchdowns. Sophomore RB Kylin James threw UCA's only touchdown pass, an 80-yard halfback pass to junior WR Jarrod Barnes. ames also caught six passes for 99 yards, while Barnes finished with three receptions for 113 yards.

UCA's other highlight was an 85-yard fumble return for a touchdown by transfer DB T.D. Williams that gave the Bears a 14-7 lead midway through the second quarter.

But UCA also allowed a 97-yard kickoff return by SEMO's Dalyn McDonald, the second 95+ yard KO return for a touchdown allowed this season

PLAYERS OF THE WEEK:

UCA nabbed three of the four ASUN Conference Player of the Week honors on Sept. 19 following a 31-16 road victory over Idaho State.

Junior LB Corley Hooper was named the ASUN Defensive Player of the Week, sophomore RB Darius Hale earned the ASUN Offensive Player of the Week honor and redshirt freshman DB Sean Smith was named the ASUN Freshman of the Week.

Hooper, a transfer from Itawamba Community College and a native of Ecru, Miss., finished with seven tackles, including 1.5 tackles for loss and a half sack. He also intercepted his first pass in the end zone in the first quarter that squelched an Idaho State drive and scooped up a fumble and scored a third-quarter touchdown. Hooper was an honorable mention for the STATS Perform National Defensive Player of the Week.

Hale, from Pearland, Texas and the reigning ASUN Freshman of the Year, scored all three of UCA's offensive touchdowns. He had scoring runs of 2 and 1 yards and also caught a 13-yard touchdown pass from quarterback Will McElvain, who completed 24 of 29 passes for 259 yards.

Smith, a redshirt freshman from Arlington, Texas, had his first interception late in the third guarter and also added two kickoff returns for 37 yards.

VS FRS

UCA was one of just three FCS programs to record a victory over an FBS team in 2019 (in 111 matchups), and was also the first to accomplish it. UCA went on the road and beat Western Kentucky 35-28 _ thanks to a 21-0 fourth quarter _ in Week 1 in Bowling Green, Ky.

After a pair of FBS losses in 2020 (UAB, ASU) and a loss at ASU in Week 1 of 2021, the Bears are now 3-16 all-time against FBS teams since moving up to Division I in 2006.

UCA beat in-state rival Arkansas State 28-23 in Jonesboro in 2016 for its second win. UCA's first win over an FBS opponent was against the same Western Kentucky team in 2009.

UCA has had close calls over the years, losing 25-20 to Hawaii in 2009 after leading with two minutes remaining, 48-42 in overtime to Louisiana Tech in 2011, 38-24 at Colorado in 2013 and 42-35 at Texas Tech in 2014. The Bears also trailed Oklahoma State 17-8 late in the third quarter of a 32-8 loss in 2015. UCA also led Ole Miss 20-14 at halftime of a 49-27 loss in 2012 in Oxford, Miss.

LARGEST CROWDS:

The largest crowd the Bears ever played in front of was at Texas Tech in 2014 in Lubbock (60,778). Last Saturday's meeting with Ole Miss ranks second all time

2022 SCHEDULE:

The Bears will have another formidable schedule this season, playing at FBS Ole Miss on Sept. 10. It will be the 16th consecutive season UCA has played an FBS opponent, including the second matchup with the Rebels in Oxford, Miss. UCA last faced Ole Miss in 2012 at Vaught Hemingway Stadium, losing 49-27 after leading 20-14 midway through the third quarter.

First-time opponents on the 2022 schedule include Idaho State, Kennesaw State and Lindenwood.

INJURIES:

UCA played the first two weeks of the season without All-ASUN guard Jaylin Hendrix, who returned for the Idaho State game.

Wide receiver/kick returner Christian Richmond missed the Ole Miss and

Idaho State games but should return for Southeast Missouri.

QUICK TRIP:

The Bears flew to Pocatallo, Idaho via charter flight and were gone from Conway less than 48 hours. UCA left campus early Friday morning and returned before midnight on Saturday, flying out of Little Rock directly to Pocatello.

It was UCA's first game against a team from the state of Idaho.

HC NATHAN BROWN:

UCA head coach Nathan Brown will be entering his fifth season as head coach and his 13th season overall on the UCA coaching staff. The former record-setting UCA quarterback served as offensive coordinator and quarterbacks coach from 2014-17 under Steve Campbell. Brown, from nearby Russellville, Ark., threw for 10,558 yards and 100 touchdowns during his record-setting career at UCA (2005-09).

HALE TO THE BACKS:

Sophomore running back Darius Hale was the runnerup for the 2021 Jerry Rice Award, which goes to the top FCS freshman in the country. Hale rushed for 1,015 yards on 198 carries (5.1 average) and scored 17 rushing touchdowns and one receiving TD. He was named the ASUN Freshman of the Year and was a first-team Freshman All-American by Hero Sports, and a third-team All-American by Stats Perform. His 17 rushing touchdowns was second in the nation.

Hale had the second-best rushing game in UCA history when he ran for 253 yards on 22 carries (11.5 average) and scored 4 touchdowns in a victory over Lamar. The school record is held by Blake Veasley, also against Lamar, with 292 yards in 2015.

Hale's season rushing yardage was the fourth-best for a UCA freshman in school history, and his 17 rushing touchdowns (2nd in the nation) was the best by a UCA running back since Brent Grimes had 19 in 2009.

Hale will be joined in a crowded running back room by returning sophomores Trysten Smith (60 rushes, 290 yards, 1 TD) and Kylin James (29-221, 1 TD), who gave the Bears an outstanding three-headed monster last season, combining for 1,526 rushing yards and 19 touchdowns, along with 24 receptions for 178 yards. Waiting in the wings are redshirt freshman Derrick "Duece" Wise (Fort Smith, Ark.) and newcomers Isaiah Broadway (Lancaster, Texas) and Travelle Anderson (Gosnell, Ark.).

REMEMBERING GT43:

UCA's tight end room lost several players after last season, including starters Jack Short and Sam Camargo to graduation, and Garrett Thomas, who died in a tragic campus accident in March 2022. The returnees are junior Austin Eldridge (Plant City, Fla.), junior Riyada Anada (Fort Smith, Ark.), Will Tyndall (Brandon, Miss.) and Haze Denton (Conway, Ark.). Newcomers include FR Tyler Siddons (Salem, Ark.), FR Jordan Owens (Coffeyville CC) and Drake Avery (Baptist Prep in Little Rock), a converted lineman.



The Bears have dedicated the 2022 season to the popular Thomas, a former walk-on from Argyle (Texas) High School, who was scheduled to go on scholarship following spring practice. UCA will wear #43 stickers on their helmets in memory of Thomas.

RECEIVING ROOM:

The Bears must replace their top two receivers, both All-Americans at various times in their careers. Junior Tyler Hudson transferred to Louisville (and started in their season opener on Saturday) after leading the Bears with 62 receptions for 1,242 yards (school record) and 8 touchdowns, giving him a school-record 3,062 yards and 167 receptions (second all-time) for his career.

Lujuan Winningham, who had a season of eligibility remaining, signed a free-agent contract with the Jacksonville Jaguars after catching 53 passes for 840 yards and 5 touchdowns in nine games last season. He ranks in the top five in all UCA receiving categories.

In all, UCA must replace 174 receptions, 2,470 receiving yards and 19 receiving touchdowns from the 2021 squad.

The top returning UCA receiver is junior Christian Richmond, who finished the 2021 season with 31 receptions for 342 vards and 6 touchdowns. Richmond, who missed most of the 2020 season with a knee injury, also led the Bears in kickoff returns last season with 18 returns for 510 yards (28.3 aver-

He should get help this season from returnees Jarrod Barnes, Myles Butler and Miles Kitt-Denton, along with transfers John David White (Arkansas), Trustin Oliver (Colorado), Cole Brown (Iowa Western CC) and Nnandi Adim-Madumere (Minnesota). The Bears also signed four high school receivers in Manny Smith (Conway, Ark.), Isaiah King (Manvel, Texas), Chris Wolfe (Valdosta, Ga.) and Triston Edwards (Red Oak, Texas).

NEW SIGNAL-CALLERS:

For the first time in several years, a quarterback other than Breylin Smith will be behind center when the Bears open the 2022 season.

On top of that loss, three other returnees transferred or left the program, including Darius Bowers, Hunter Loyd and Tyler Gee. Smith finished No. 2 in school history (behind Brown) in passing TDs, passing yards and total offense. He completed 220 of 340 passes (64.7%) for 2,884 yards and 26 touchdowns last season.

Due to injuries and covid-19, the Conway High School product who redshirted at UCA in 2016 actually had one more year of eligibility remaining.

Two newcomers headline the position, starting with Northern Iowa transfer Will McElvain. He played in four games for the Panthers last fall after starting five games in their spring 2021 season. His best year was 2019 when he threw for 2,778 yards and 20 touchdowns, setting a UNI freshman passing record, and was named a freshman All-American.

The other transfer QB is Clifton McDowell from Kilgore CC and previously at Louisiana-Lafayette. McDowell was rated the 34th-best dualthreat quarterback in the 2019 class and was a 247 Sports three-star recruit. He accounted for 37 touchdowns during his senior season, passing for 1,820 yards and 18 TDs, while rushing for 1,330 yards and 19 TDs.

UCA also signed quarterback Austin Myers from nearby Vilonia (Ark.) High School and Cade Sipe from Harding Academy in Searcy, Ark.

The only player returning for the Bears that completed a pass last season is a running back, SO Kylin James (Dumas, Ark.), who went 1 for 1 with a 42yard touchdown pass to Tyler Hudson at Lamar.

GETTING DEFENSIVE:

UCA returns four of its top seven tacklers from a year ago, including No. 1 tackler Tamuarion Wilson, a third-year sophomore safety from Bryant, Ark. Wilson finished with 66 total tackles, including 44 solos, while adding 3.5 tackles for loss, 1 interception, 2 fumble recoveries and one forced fumble. He also has four pass breakups.

All-ASUN junior defensive end Logan Jessup (Wynne, Ark.) led the Bears in both tackles for loss (11, -35 yards) and sacks (5, -20 yards), while forcing and recovering one fumble and finishing with 60 total tackles. He also led the ASUN in TFLs.

UCA's Nos. 2-3 tacklers safety Deandre Lamont (transfer to Illinois State) and linebacker Trenton Dunn (graduate) will both have to be replaced. Key newcomers on the defensive side of the ball include transfers: LB Noah Mitchell; LB Corley Hooper; DE Jace McCoy; DE David Walker; DT Stephon McGlaun and Javeon Jones; DB Tra Green; DB CJ Bosket and DB Ta'Darius

Returning experience includes: DT Caden Brown; DL Jalen Bedell; DB Cameron Godfrey; LB Darin Davenport; DB Kameryn Cuevas; DB Nathan Page; DB Christian Cain and DE Marquez Casey.

SPECIALTIES:

One of the most prolific placekickers in UCA history returns for his senior season. Hayden Ray (Bryant, Ark.) is tied for 2nd in school history in PATs (138 of 140, 98.5%) and fifth in field goals (36). He has scored 246 career points (6th in UCA history). Sophomore punter Chandler Caughron also returns after averaging 41.7 yards per punt in 2021, as does snapper Justin Keijers, a junior from Valrico, Fla.

FIRST-TIME OPPONENTS:

The Bears will be playing three teams for the first time in school history this season. The newcomers include: Idaho State on Sept. 17 in Pocatello, Idaho; Lindenwood on Oct. 8 in Conway, and Kennesaw State on Oct. 15 in Kennesaw, Ga.

5. 36 - Hayden Ray (2017-)

The ISU Bengals, under first-year head coach Charlie Ragle, compete in the Big Sky Conference along with the likes of Montana, Montana State, Eastern Washington, Sacramento State and UC Davis, all of which made the FCS Playoffs in 2021.

Kennesaw, in just its eighth season of football, is an ASUN team along with UCA. Lindenwood, in St. Charles, Mo., is a first-year NCAA Division I program competing in the Ohio Valley Conference after moving up from Division II

The Bears closed out the 2021 season with three of their final four opponents being first-timers (Jacksonville State, Texas Wesleyan, Tarleton State).

INAUGURAL ASUN RACE:

The Bears competed in the ASUN-WAC AQ7 series a year ago, with the ASUN joining with the Western Athletic Conference for scheduling purposes and to retain an automatic qualifier for the FCS Playoffs.

The ASUN will play a full schedule this season, with each school playing five conference games. UCA hosts Austin Peay (Oct.1), North Alabama (Oct. 29) and Jacksonville State (Nov. 19), while going on the road to face Kennesaw State (Oct. 15) and Eastern Kentucky (Nov. 5).

2021 ALL-ASUN TEAM:

UCA earned a league-best 10 places on the 2021 All-ASUN team last December, along with the ASUN Freshman of the Year (RB Darius Hale) and the

Others named to the All-ASUN team were offensive linemen Toby Sanderson, Jaylin Hendrix and Justin Lairy, with the latter two both returning in 2022, DE Logan Jessup, LB T.J. Campbell, DBs Cameron Godfrey and Deandre Lamont and punter Chandler Caughron.

THE STRIPES:

The Bears will host five regular-season games this season at First Security Field at Estes Stadium, also know as "The Stripes". A brand new turf was installed last season, replacing the original Stripes installed in 2011

The Bears are 43-12 since the arrival of the unique purple and gray stripes playing surface. UCA went a perfect 11-0 on "The Stripes" through the first two seasons on the turf (2011-12).

Over the past 16 seasons since moving to Division I, UCA's home record is 67-20, including 7-0 in 2008, 5-0 in 2011, 6-0 in 2012 and 3-0 in 2020.

ASUN POWS:

UCA took home 13 ASUN Player of the Week honors in 2021.

QB Breylin Smith was named the ASUN Offensive Player of the Week three times, while WR Tyler Hudson earned two honors.

UCA had four Defensive Players of the Week, including DB Deandre Lamont (twice), DE Logan Jessup and DB Christian Cain.

The Bears earned four Freshman of the Week awards, including three for RB Darius Hale and one for RB Trysten Smith.

ASUN RANKS:

UCA led the ASUN in pass efficiency (157.2), passing offense (300.5 yds per game), first downs (22.8 per game) PAT kicking (52 of 52) and fourth-down conversions (5 of 8).

The Bears were second in scoring offense (34.3), total offense (449.4), kickoff returns (24.8), turnover margin (+4), third-down conversions (44.4%) and opponent penalties (67). They were third in rushing offense (148.9) and red-zone offense (88.4%).

Individually, Tyler Hudson was No. 1 in receptions (6.0 per game), receiving yards per game (120.0) and all-purpose yards (128.1). Breylin Smith was first in passing (287.1) and passing TDs (26). Darius Hale was 2nd in rushing (95.2 per game), first in scoring (10.2 per game) and second in all-purpose (106.0). DE Logan Jessup tied for first in sacks (7) and was second in TFLs (11.5).

DEGREES IN THE POCKET:

According to the National Football Foundation (NFF), there are 3,113 football student-athletes competing this fall that have already earned undergraduate degrees. UCA contributes nine of those, including:

TE Riyadh Anada (Computer Science); WR Jarrod Barnes (Business Administration); DL Caden Brown (Physical Educ./Teacher Educ.); DB Kamryn Cuevas (Family and Consumer Science); DB Simeon Dotson (Family and Consumer Science); TE Austin Eldridge (Innovation and Entrepreneurship); DB Cameron Godfrey (Nutrition); DE Logan Jessup (PETE), and PK Hayden Ray (Health Promotions).

This year's number is slightly lower than last year (3,284) but considerably higher than in 2019 (1,452) or 2017 (971).

THE ROSTER:

UCA has 45 newcomers on the 2022 roster, including 22 transfers from either juco or four-year schools.

The Bears signed a class of 36 back on national signing day in February, and have since added more. The signing class included eight receivers, seven offensive linemen, five defensive linemen, five linebackers, five defensive backs, three quarterbacks, two running backs and one tight end.

The breakdown by states was 12 from Arkansas, nine from Mississippi, six from Texas, two from Georgia and one each from Oklahoma, Alabama, Minnesota, Iowa, California, South Carolina and Kansas.

Twenty-one of those signees were mid-year enrollees, a record for UCA. Five of those are penciled in as starters on the first two-deep of the season (C Jack Green, QB Will McElvain, DE David Walker, LB C.J. Bosket, CB T.D. Williams). In all, 13 are on the first depth chart.

WATCHING WALTER:

Sophomore running back Darius Hale was named on Aug. 3 to the Walter Payton Award watch list. The award is named for the NFL Hall of Famer who played collegiately at Jackson State in the early 1980s and goes to the top FCS offensive player in the nation.

Past winners of the Payton Award include Steve McNair, Tony Romo, Jimmy Garrapalo, Cooper Cupp and Trey Lance. UCA competed against both Cupp (Eastern Washington) and Lance (North Dakota State).

This season, UCA will face six players on the Payton Award Watch list, including Missouri State QB Jason Shelley, Kennesaw State QB Xavier Shepherd, Southeast Missouri RB Geno Hess, Eastern Kentucky QB Parker McKinney and SFA QB Trae Self and WR Xavier Gipson.

SEASON / HOME OPENERS:

UCA had won 23 consecutive home openers at Estes Stadium, dating back to a 1999 loss to perennial D-II power North Alabama, until the loss to Missouri State on Sept. 1.

UCA's win over Arkansas-Pine Bluff (45-23) on Sept. 18 of last year was the 23th consecutive win. A 27-20 win over Missouri State on Sept. 26, 2000 was No. 22.

UCA's mark was tied for the secod best in FCS with North Dakota State, which ironically beat UCA in its 2020 home opener (actualy only game of the fall). North Dakota holds the top streak at 33 straight games.

In overall season openers (home or away) since moving to NCAA Division I in 2006, the Bears are now 9-8, with six of those losses coming on the road against FBS teams, including Kansas State, Texas Tech, Ole Miss, Tulsa, Louisiana Tech and Hawaii.

AFFILIATIONS:

The timeline for the Bears ascension to NCAA Division I FCS began at the NAIA level. UCA competed in the NAIA until 1993 when it left the Arkansas Intercollegiate Conference and moved to NCAA Division II and into the Gulf South Conference.

UCA remained there until 2006-07 when it made the move to D-I and into the Southland Conference in July 2006. The Bears spent 15 years in

the SLC before making the move to the ASUN in on July 1, 2021.

UCA finished its run in the SLC with an impressive 73-29-0 conference record, a .716 winning percentage. That includes an 9-0 record in 2017, 8-1 mark in 2016, 6-1 records in 2008, 2011 and 2012 and a 7-2 mark in 2015 and 2019.

FCS PLAYOFF HISTORY:

UCA has made five appearances in the NCAA Division I FCS Playoffs since moving up in 2006-07. UCA beat Tennessee Tech in the first round in 2011 (34-14 in Cookeville, Tenn.), then lost to Montana 41-14 in Missoula.

In 2012, the Bears lost their opening game at Georgia Southern 24-16 in Statesboro, Ga. UCA hosted Illinois State in 2016 in the first round and won 31-24 before losing 31-14 at Eastern Washington in Cheney, Wash.

UCA was also nationally seeded in 2017 and hosted New Hampshire in the second round but lost 21-15. In 2019, UCA earned a No. 8 national seed and drew a bye before losing 24-14 to Illinois State in the second round on "The Stripes" in Conway.

WINNING WAYS:

UCA enters 2022 as the winningest college football program in the state of Arkansas since 2000. The Bears went 10-2 season in 2008, the best record in the Division I era.

UCA has recorded 40 winning seasons in the past 47 years, dating back to 1973. UCA tied the school record with 11 victories in 2005, and won 10 games in both 2016 and 2017

COACHING STAFF:

UCA head coach Nathan Brown has retained both of his coordinators in Ken Collums (offense) and Matt Kitchens (defense) for 2022.

The only new full-time addition to the coaching staff is Raleigh Jackson (linebackers). Jackson coached previously at Henderson State, Arkansas Tech, Delta State, Slippery Rock, the Citadel and Missouri Southern.

Others joining the UCA staff this season are Jake Walker (defensive graduate assistant/LB), Blaze Barista (defensive quality control/OLB), Luke Sexton (special teams quality control/video) and Corbin Boler (offensive quality control/OL).

SCORING STREAK:

The Bears had a streak of 274 games in which they scored broken with the shutout loss to Southeastern Louisiana on Nov. 9, 2019. The last shutout overall prior to that was when UCA lost 19-0 at Delta State in 1995. The last shutout at home prior to that was 1986 against East Central Oklahoma in the NAIA days. The Bears have now scored in 407 of their last 409 games since 1986.

600TH WIN:

The Bears recorded their 600th victory in school history last season with a 38-14 victory over Jacksonville State on the road in Jacksonville, Ala. UCA's 550th win came back in 2015 when the Bears beat Northwestern State in Natchitoches, La. The first victory in school history was a 5-0 win over Arkansas Medics on Oct. 24, 1908.

BEING OFFENSIVE:

The Bears' offense was consistently prolific during their time in the Division I era, averaging close to 5,000 yards per season in 15 years in the Southland Conference. The high was 5,584 in 2017. They topped 5,000 yards of total offense six times, including four of the past six years.

UCA has averaged nearly 3,100 passing yards per season, with a high of 3,979 in 2013. The Bears have averaged 26 passing touchdowns over that time period (high of 34 in 2011) and have topped the 3,000-yard passing mark nine times in 14 seasons.

BEAR TRACKS...

- UCA has been outscored 38-0 in the first quarter through four games this season.
- UCA started the 2011 season with a 1-3 record and then won seven straight regular-season games, and a first-round FCS Playoff game (at Tennessee Tech) before losing at Montana in the second round. UCA finished 9-4 overall.
- The Bears are converting 77% (10 of 13) of their red-zone chances this season.
- T.D. Williams' 85-yard fumble return for a touchdown against SEMO was UCA's

second in two weeks. LB Corley Hooper returned one 3 yards for a score at Idaho State on 9/17.

- RB Kylin James completed his second TD pass of his young career against SEMO, hitting Jarrod Barnes with an 80-yard strike. He connected with Tyler Hudson on a 42-yard TD pass last season at Lamar.
- UCA's 16 rushing yards at SEMO was the lowest since they had 39 vs. Incarnate Word on 11/10/18.
- Will McElvain's 82.7 percent completion rate against Idaho State (24 of 29) was the 9th best in school history. Ironically, his head coach Nathan Brown has four of the top 8 performances. Zak Clark is first at 100% (11 of 11) vs. Iowa Wesleyan in 2004. Andy Rogers is 2nd (14 of 15, 93.3%) vs. Henderson State in 2001.
- Corley Hooper's 3-yd fumble return for a touchdown at ISU was UCA's first since Logan Jessup had a 26-yarder against Missouri Wester on 11/31/20.
- UCA's three offensive scoring drives vs. Idaho State took 2:48, 1:44 and 2:57.
- UCA won the turnover battle vs. Idaho State 3-1.
- In the final three quarters, UCA outgained ISU 389 to 238 yards.
- Kemari (KC) Clark had his first career INT vs. Ole Miss, and UCA's first of the season. LB Corley Hooper and DB Sean Smith had their first picks in the win over Idaho State on Sept. 17.
- The Idaho State game was UCA's only flight of the season, at least during the regular season. The remaining trips are bus trips. It was also ust the second game played indoors by the Bears (loss at North Dakota State in 2020).
- The Bears played 60 players in their season opener vs. Missouri State, with 19 newcomers seeing their first action.
- David Walker's four tackles for loss vs. Missouri State tied for the third-most in UCA history. The school record is 5.0 by Icsom Jones (2003, @ OBU).
- · Seven different Bears had a least a half tackle for loss vs. MSU.
- In four games against Missouri State over the past three years, UCA has recorded a combined 44 tackles for loss for a combined 203 yards. UCA also had 24 sacks for a combined 152 lost yards.
- Myles Butler (Montgomery, Ala.) caught his first TD pass vs. Missouri State, a 7-yarder in the fourth quarter.
- The Bears will be playing two teams (Missouri State, Eastern Kentucky) for the fourth time in three seasons after a home-and-home series with each during the covid-19 2020 season.
- The Bears won their 18th Homecoming game in the past 19 last season, improving UCA's homecoming record to 64-27-1.
- There are 49 Bears from Arkansas on the roster, the most of any state and more than double No. 2 Texas (19).

OVER THE AIRWAVES:

The UCA Radio Network returns for the 17th year in the capable hands of Justin Acri (play by play), along with Chris Kane (color) and Steve Owens (sideline) on 103.7 The Buzz and The Bear 91.3.

The UCA games will be carried live on The Point 94.1, a 100,000-watt classic rock station based out of Little Rock, and KUCA 91.3 The Bear.

Acri, the general manager and midday talk show host at KABZ 103.7 The Buzz, will handle the play-by-play duties this season, his seventh in that role after nine years of color commentary. Kane, the former morning co-host of KATV's Daybreak, assumed the color commentary role six years ago. Steve Owens, the director of UCA's campus station KUCA 91.3 and the play-by-play voice for UCA women's basketball and baseball, will handle sideline duties for the first season.

FAMOUS ALUMS:

UCA's most famous football alumnus is Monte Coleman, who played 16 seasons (1979-94) with the Washington Redskins and won three Super Bowl titles. Coleman, from Pine Bluff, Ark., was a linebacker and safety at UCA from 1975-78 and is the former head football coach at Arkansas-Pine Bluff.

UCA's most famous non-football alum is Scottie Pippen, a six-time NBA champion and two-time Olympic Dream Teamer. Pippen grew up in tiny Hamburg, Ark. in the SE Arkansas delta region and played at UCA from 1983-87 as a walk-on before becoming a two-time first-team NAIA All-American and then going 5th in the 1987 NBA Draft.

The court at the Farris Center was named for Pippen in the summer of 2021, with his signature added to midcourt.

RADIO SHOW:

The Nathan Brown Show will be heard every Monday night at 7 p.m. on The Buzz II with Justin Acri, live from Walk-Ons Conway.

The hour-long show will feature head coach Nathan Brown, his coaching staff and selected players throughout the season, along with Acri, who is UCA's game day play-by-play radio announcer.

HEAD COACH NATHAN BROWN

The most prolific quarterback in University of Central Arkansas history became the 20th head coach of the program in December 2017 when Nathan Brown was hired to replace Steve Campbell.


Brown, a 2016 inductee in the UCA Sports Hall of Fame in his first year of eligibility, spent the previous four years (2014-17) as the Bears' offensive coordinator on teams that went 33-15 (.688), including 20-5 (.800) in 2016-17 and had the most efficient passing offense in the FCS in 2017.

Brown, a native of Russellville, Ark., led the Bears to a 6-5 mark in his first season as head coach in 2018. Of the five losses by the Bears, two were by three or less points, including one in overtime. UCA finished 5-4 in Southland Conference play.

The Bears had the No. 4 scoring offense in the league, the No. 2 rushing defense and the No. 3 scoring defense.

In Year 2, the Bears finished 9-4 overall and went 7-2 in conference play (co-champions), earning a No. 8 national seeding in the FCS Playoffs and a bye in the first round before hosting Illinois State at First Security Field at Estes Stadium. The playoff appearance was the fifth overall and third in the previous four years.

UCA not only survived but thrived during the pandemic season of 2020, playing a full fall schedule when many programs sat out



The Bears came back with another tough schedule in 2021, playing FBS Arkansas State, along with a slate of games in the new ASUN/WAC Challenge in UCA's first year in the ASUN.

Since arriving on the UCA campus as a student-athlete in 2004, Brown has immersed himself in the football program here as not only a player, but as a coach. While playing at UCA, he was a record breaking starting quarterback

and a 3-time All American player who was UCA's first player to participate in the prestigious Senior Bowl.

As a coach, Brown's offenses totaled 20,969 yards and averaged 437 yards per game during his years as offensive coordinator, while having three different quarterbacks being named first-team All-Southland Conference (Hayden Hildebrand 2017, Wynrick Smothers 2012, Nathan Dick 2011). Hildebrand was the SLC Player of the Year while Smothers was the SLC Offensive Player of the Year.

During his years as quarterbacks coach at UCA, the Bears' quarterbacks averaged 3,211 passing yards per season, eclipsing the 3,000-yard yard plateau six times, for a total of 25,691 yards. With Brown as the Bears' offensive coordinator, UCA had 17 All-SLC offensive first or second team selections, including a Freshman, Player and two Offensive Linemen of the Year selections. The Bears ranked in the Top 10 in FCS scoring three times in four years, and ranked seventh in the country in total offense in 2017.

Brown coached four of the top six total offense seasons in school history, and he was the starting quarterback for the other two seasons. He also played or





coached in seven of the top 10 passing offensive seasons in program history. Brown has been a part of three Southland Conference championships, one as player in 2008 and two as an assistant coach in 2012 and 2017.

Brown has been a part of all four of UCA's NCAA postseason playoff victories, two as a player (Division II) and two as a coach (FCS). UCA also won three Southland Conference championships, in 2008 (as a player), 2012 and 2017 (as a coach).

Equally as impressive as his coaching credentials are his numbers from his playing days at UCA. Brown was a three-time All-American who threw for 10,558 yards and 100 touchdowns in his career, both records for a collegiate quarterback in the state of Arkansas. The Bears went 30-10 with Brown as the starting quarterback.

He was the SLC Offensive Player of the Year in 2007 and the SLC Player of the Year in 2008, when he was also a Walter Payton Award finalist. Brown also owns school records for touchdown passes in a game (7) and most yards of total offense (490).

Before UCA moved to Division I in 2006, Brown was named the Gulf South Conference Freshman of the year in 2005.

Brown was UCA's first player to receive an invitation to the Senior Bowl All-Star game in the NCAA Division I era and was the leading passer in the 2009 game. He was also selected for the East-West Shrine Game that same year. He was a free-agent signee of both the Jacksonville Jaguars and New Orleans Saints.

Brown received his bachelor's degree in business education from the University of Central Arkansas in 2009 after graduating from Russellville High School in 2004.

He and his wife, Jessica (also a UCA graduate) have two children, daughter Rylee and son Luke.




