THE SERIES:

The Bears and Lumberjacks will be meeting for the 17th time on Saturday, with UCA leading the all-time series 12-4. UCA is 6-2 in games played in Conway.

The game will not count as a conference game since it was already scheduled before the formation of the UAC.

UCA won last year's meeting 34-7 at Homer Bryce Stadium in Nacogdoches. UCA then-sophomore RB Kylin James had 10 carries for 155 yards and caught four passes for 88 yards and two touchdowns. The Bears totaled 407 yards of offense and held the Lumberjacks to 258 on 16 more offensive snaps.

SFA starting quarterback Trae Self was just 10 of 21 for 45 yards passing. All-American wide receiver Xavier Gipson had 3 catches for 12 yards, 1 punt return for -1 yards and 1 kickoff return for 36 yards. That pair hooked up for a pair of touchdown catches in SFA's 27-14 win the previous year in Conway.

UCA's Hayden Ray added a pair of field goals and Jarrod Barnes returned a punt 67 yards for a TD. SFA's only score came on a touchdown pass from current QB Brian Maurer to Griffin Edwards with 1:38 remaining.

LAST WEEK:

The Bears had the comeback of all comebacks in a 38-33 victory over the SEMO Redhawks last Saturday at Estes Stadium.

UCA trailed 30-6 heading into the fourth quarter, but outscored SEMO 32-3 with touchdowns on five straight possessions. The final one, a nine-yard run by Kylin James, came with just 19 seconds on the clock. The last three game in the final 4:01

UCA's scoring drives in the fourth quarter took 1:27, 3:23, :19, :41 and :59. The Bears outgained the Redhawks 271-71 in the final period. SEMO's final five drives were punt, field goal, punt, punt and interception by junior safety TaMuarion Wilson in the end zone as time expired.

QB Will McElvain had his second straight career high with 397 passing yards, completing 31 of 44 with 4 touchdowns and 1 interception. All four TD passes were in the fourth quarter.

WEEK 5:

The Bears made the long trip to Utah and brought home a 29-27 victory over Southern Utah in UAC play. UCA improved to 2-0 in the league by shutting down the Thunderbirds' offense, holding them to 232 yards of total offense. It was the second straight week UCA allowed an opponent just 232 yards (Abilene Christian).

The Bears totaled 468 yards of offense, including 349 passing yards by senior QB Will McElvain, tying his career high. He completed touchdown passes of 18 and 17 yards to RB Kylin James, and 4 yards to TE Jordan Owens. Junior PK Jake Gaster kicked three field goals (34, 34, 21).

UCA's defense finished with 9.0 tackles for loss and a pair of sacks by Javeon Jones and David Walker. Safety TaMuarion Wilson had an interception and DE Logan Jessup recovered a fumble.

It was the first meeting between the Bears and Thunderbirds.

WEEK 4:

The Bears took care of business in their UAC opener against Abilene Christian, rolling to a 52-17 victory at Estes Stadium.

UCA totaled a season-high 594 yards of total offense, including 380 yards on the ground. Junior RB ShunDerrick Powell led that charge with a career-high 256 yards rushing, including a 95-yard touchdown run that pushed UCA's lead to 45-10 early in the fourth quarter. Powell also caught three passes for 25 yards and another touchdown as the Bears scored 38 consecutive points after trailing 10-7 late in the first quarter.

The UCA defense held ACU to just 232 yards of total offense, and just 118 over the final three quarters. ACU rushed for 43 yards on 22 carries and passed for 189 yards. After taking a 10-7 lead, the Wildcats had two fumbles and seven punts over their next nine possessions, with no possession lasting longer than 2:38. ACU, which was just 3 of 12 on third-down conversions, and lost the time of possession battle 35:21 to 24:39.

UCA finished with 28 first downs (13 rushing, 13 passing, 2 penalty) and averaged 7.8 yards per offensive play. The Bears also won the turnover battle 2-0 and scored a defensive touchdown when DE Deorius Cobbs forced a fumble and LB Jake Golday fell on it in the end zone.

WEEK 3:

The Bears put up a good fight at No. 2 North Dakota State on Sept. 16 in Fargo, N.D. before falling 49-21 to the nine-time FCS national champion.

The Bears totaled 431 yards of total offense and scored the most points allowed by the Bison this season and tied for the second most since 2010. The most allowed was 45 points to South Dakota State in the 2022 national championship game.

Junior running back ShunDerrick Powell supplied much of the Bears' offense, rushing 18 times for 218 yards (12.1 per carry) and two touchdowns (and one called back by penalty), catching 4 passes for 30 yards and returning four kickoffs for 99 yards, giving him 347 all-purpose yards. Powell was the first running back to top 200 yards against the Bison since 2010.

Powell had touchdown runs of 43 and 71 yards. UCA also got touchdowns from RB Darius Hale and a 4-yard touchdown pass from QB Will McElvain to WR Myles Butler. Jake Gaster added his first career field goal at UCA from 35 yards.

Defensively, LB Demetrias Charles led the way with 8 tackles, while TaMuarion Wilson and Kendarrus Moore added six each. Wilson had 1.5 tackles for loss, while DE David Walker had 1.5 sacks among his five tackles.

UCA had a pair of turnovers, which both led to NDSU scores. The first was a deflected pass that Eli Mostaert picked out of the air and returned 35 yards for a touchdown. The second, a UCA fumble at midfield on its first possession of the second half, turned into a touchdown for the Bisons.

WEEK 2:

The Bears accomplished what they wanted to in a 70-2 victory over outmanned Texas College in their home opener on "The Stripes."

UCA score twice in the opening 1:22, led 35-0 after one quarter and 49-0 at halftime in cruising to its first victory of the season. The Steers (0-2), an NAIA school from Tyler, Texas, was a late fill-in after a scheduling issue involving Arkansas-Pine Bluff left UCA without a home game on Sept. 9.

The Bears rolled up 499 yards of total offense and played 90 players in the expected rout. Eight different players scored a touchdown, including two apiece from running backs ShunDerrick Powell and Kylin James. UCA punter Chandler Caughron, who averaged 46.2 yards in the opening game at Oklahoma State, did not see the field Saturday, as did 8-10 other Bears who were battling or resting nagging injuries.

Texas College's lone score came on a safety after Jacobrien Eicheberger's interception near the UCA goal line and an unsportsmanlike penalty that put the ball on the 2.

UCA rushed for 396 yards, with nine different players with at least one carry. James finished with 103 yards on 10 carries, while Powell had 87 on just three rushes. The Bears played two quarterbacks (Will McElvain/Austin Myers), who combined to complete 8 of 11 passes for 103 yards and a touchdown.

The 70 points tied UCA's Division I-era high, set twice before against Houston Baptist (2014) and Bacone College (2012).

Ninety players saw action in the game for the Bears.

WEEK 1:

The Bears put a scare into the FBS Oklahoma State Cowboys before fallig 27-13 at Boone Pickens Stadium in Stillwater, Okla.

UCA scored a touchdown on a 1-yard pass from Will McElvain to Kylin James with 4:37 left in the third quarter to draw the Bears within 13-7. The Cowboys then outscored the Bears 14-6 down the stretch to earn their second win over the Bears in two tries.

UCA finished with 391 yards of total offense compared to 453 for OSU. Senior QB Will McElvain completed 24 of 37 passes for 268 yards, with a pair of touchdowns and no interceptions. The second TD pass was a 2-yarder to senior WR Christian Richmond with 3:28 to play.

Transfer ShunDerrick Powell led all rushers with 71 yards on 12 carries. James and Richmond both had five receptions, while senior Jarrod Barnes had four catches for a team-high 94 yards.

Defensively, LB Jake Golday had 9 tackles, while CB Andrew Hayes and DE/LB David Walker had 8 each. Sophomore LB Demetrias Charles intercepted OSU on the Cowboys' first possession of the game.

Junior punter Chandler Caughron punted six times for 46.2 yards.

PLAYERS OF THE WEEK:

- UCA QB Will McElvain was named the UAC Offensive Player of the Week on Oct. 9 after leading the Bears to a huge comeback win over SEMO. McElvain completed 31 of 44 passes for a career-high 397 yards, with four TD pass, all in the decisive fourth quarter of a 38-33 win.

- UCA junior running back ShunDerrick Powell earned not one but two Offensive Player of the Week honors on Sept 26.

Powell, a 5-9, 180-pounder from Hoxie, Ark., was named the UAC Offensive Player of the Week, as well as the FedEx Ground FCS National Offensive Player of the Week.

Powell rushed for a career-high 256 yards on 23 carries (11.1 per carry) in UCA's 52-17 win over Abilene Christian last Saturday at Estes Stadium. Powell had a 14-yard touchdown reception and a career-long 95-yard rushing TD.

The 200+ rushing game was the second straight for Powell and the sixth of his career, dating back to last season at North Alabama. He also ran for 218 yards at No. 2 North Dakota State the previous week.

Powell is No. 2 in the nation in rushing yards (744), rushing yards per game (148.8) and No. 1 rushing yards per carry (10.2).

THE 200 CLUB:

Only four UCA running backs have run for 200+ yards twice in their careers, and two of them are on the current roster. ShunDerrick Powell did it in back to back games the past two weeks, while Darius Hale did it once last season and once as a freshman in 2021.

Only two have done it twice in the same season, including Henry Hawk (twice in 1959). Vaughan Edwards (1978, 1979) is the only other two-time member of the 200 Club.

The UCA single-game record is Blake Veasley's 292 yards (49 carries) at Lamar on Oct. 24, 2015.

UP, UP AND AWAY:

The Bears played at the highest altitude in school history against Southern Utah. The elevation of Cedar City, Utah, is 5,800 feet. The previous high was at Colorado in 2013 (5,318).

THE UAC:

The Bears are in a new football-only conference for the second time in three years. UCA joined the ASUN in 2021 but due to low numbers of football-playing schools, the league joined with the WAC the last two seasons.

This summer the conference created the United Athletic Conference (UAC), pulling together four teams from the ASUN (UCA, Austin Peay, Eastern Kentucky, North Alabama) and five from the WAC (Stephen F. Austin, Abilene Christian, Tarleton State, Southern Utah and Utah Tech).

The Bears will play six conference games in 2023, against ACU, Southern Utah, TSU, UNA, EKU and APSU.

The Bears won a share of the one and only ASUN Championship in 2022, going 3-2 in league play.

PRESEASON POLL:

UCA was the second choice in the UAC preseason coaches' poll released earlier this month. The Bears received a league-high five first-place votes but finished with 69 points, trailing only Eastern Kentucky, which had 71 points but just two first-place votes.

Rounding out the poll was Austin Peay (1/57), Stephen F. Austin (54), Abilene Christian (52), Tarleton State (37), Utah Tech and Southern Utah (25) and North Alabama (15)

UCA's opening UAC game will be at home against ACU on Sept. 23.

PRESEASON ALL-UAC:

The Bears placed a league-best seven players on the 2023 preseason All-UAC Football team as voted on by the league's coaches.

UCA was represented by running backs Darius Hale and ShunDerrick Powell, defensive ends David Walker and Logan Jessup, safety TaMuarion Wilson, punter Chandler Caughron and punt returner Jarrod Barnes.

NEW STAFF:

Defensive coordinator Greg Stewart returns to the UCA coaching staff in 2023. His previous stop with the Bears was from 2014-17. During that four-year run, the Bears won 33 games, including a pair of 10-win seasons in 2016 and 2017, with FCS Playoff appearances in both years.

Stewart left UCA to follow head coach Steve Campbell to South Alabama, then coached at his alma mater Jacksonville State.

Other additions include Walker Ashburn as interior defensive line coach, the promotion of Bayley Novak to tight ends coach, the promotion for Keith Scott to assistant head coach and the addition of run-game coordinator to Tony Davis' title.

Also, veteran Brooks Hollingsworth has retired from on-field coaching and will serve as the director of high school relations for the program.

2023 SCHEDULE:

The Bears will face another formidable schedule this season, one that includes FBS Oklahoma State to open the slate and a second trip to FCS powerhouse North Dakota State in Week. 3.

UCA will also play six regular-season home games for the first time since 2014. The Bears have played as many as six home games, including playoff games, as recently as 2019.

After opening the season on the road for two of three weeks, UCA will not leave the state of Arkansas in October, hosting Southeast Missouri, Stephen F. Austin and Tarleton State, along with its lone open date on Oct. 21.

UCA will take on two teams for the first time in Texas College (Sept. 9) and Southern Utah (Sept. 30). Three teams will be on the schedule for just the second time in Oklahoma State, NDSU and Tarleton State.

FIRST TIMERS:

The Bears will be playing two opponents for the first time this season. UCA will take on Texas College at home on Sept. 9 and at Southern Utah on Sept. 30 in Cedar City, Utah.

UCA's most-played opponent on the 2023 schedule is North Alabama (21 meetings), followed by Southeast Missouri (16) and Stephen F. Austin (16). Three teams are on the schedule for just the second time in Oklahoma State (0-1), North Dakota State (0-1) and Tarleton State (0-1).

DEGREES IN THE POCKET:

According to the National Football Foundation (NFF), there are 2,945 football student-athletes competing this fall that have already earned undergraduate degrees. UCA contributes 11 of those, including:

P Chandler Caughron (exercise science), DT Stephon McGlaun (health promotion), S Tra Green (health science), WR/PR Jarrod Barnes (MBA), DE Logan Jessup (finance), LB Darin Davenport (exercise science), TE Nnambi Adim-Madumere (economics), TE Austin Eldridge (MBA), S Cameron Godfrey (health science) and QB Will McElvain (family and consumer science).

This year's number is slightly lower than the past two years which included covid numbers (3,113 in 2022, 3,284 in 2021).

THREE-HEADED MONSTER:

The Bears will field one of the most explosive offensive backfields in the nation this season with the duo of returnees Darius Hale and Kylin James and transfer ShunDerrick Powell.

Hale has run for 2,179 yards in two+ seasons with the Bears, despite missing most of three games in 2022 with injury. He was the ASUN Freshman of the Year in 2021 when he had 1,015 rushing yards and 17 touchdowns. He was national runnerup for the Jerry Rice Award, which goes to the top freshman in FCS.

ShunDerrick Powell, a transfer from North Alabama, led the ASUN in rushing last season with 1,508 yards and 18 touchdowns and was the co-Offensive Player of the Year in the league and an All-American.

Kylin James, a junior all-purpose back, was UCA's second-leading rusher (649 yards) and tied for leading receiver (40-581) a year ago. He also threw two touchdown passes.

Between the three, they combined for 3,116 rushing yards and 31 rushing TDs in 2022.

RETURNING PRODUCTION:

UCA returns its starting quarterback, its top two rushers and its top five receivers from the 2022 season, one in which the Bears averaged 434.5 yards of total offense per game.

Those top five receivers caught a combined 154 passes for 2,340 yards and 16 touchdowns. QB Will McElvain completed 190 of 311 passes (61.1%) for 2,592 yards and 18 touchdowns (235.6 yards per game).

UCA's leading scorer, graduate placekicker Hayden Ray, will have to be replaced after scoring 81 points a year ago.

On the defensive side, UCA returns six of its top seven tacklers, led by S TaMuarion Wilson with 104 stops, the best in the ASUN. UCA also returns 29 of its 32 total sacks from a year ago, led by David Walker's 12.0. The Bears also return 60 of their 70 tackles for loss, led by Walker's 21.0.

NATIONAL HONORS

UCA defensive end David Walker was named to six All-America teams after last season, including Athlon, Associated Press, Stats Perform, Hero Sports, FCS ADA and Phil Steele.

Also earning All-America honors, and returning this season, were safety TaMuarion Wilson, punt returner Jarrod Barnes and running back ShunDerrick Powell (while at North Alabama). Graduating senior offensive lineman Jaylin Hendrix was also named an All-American.

VS. FBS

The Bears are 3-17 all-time against FBS (Football Bowl Subdivision) teams since moving up to NCAA Division I FCS in 2006. UCA has victories over Arkansas State (28-23, 2016) and Western Kentucky (twice (28-7 in 2009; 35-28 in 2019).

UCA has had close calls over the years, losing 25-20 to Hawaii in 2009 after leading with two minutes remaining, 48-42 in overtime to Louisiana Tech in 2011, 38-24 at Colorado in 2013 and 42-35 at Texas Tech in 2014. UCA also led Ole Miss 20-14 at halftime of a 49-27 loss in 2012 in Oxford, Miss.

LARGEST CROWDS:

UCA's game at Oklahoma State earlier this season was the fourth-largest crowd for a Bear game at 53,855. The previous game at Oklahoma State in 2015 was the third-largest crowd in history for the Bears (56,262), trailing only a crowd of 60,778 at Texas Tech in 2014 in Lubbock, Texas, and 58,373 last

TITLE TIME:

UCA finished 3-2 in the ASUN Conference, tied with Austin Peay and Eastern Kentucky, to finish as Tri-Champs in the league. UCA beat APSU but lost to EKV. The ASUN did not use a tiebreaker system to designate a conference champion, but rather declared tri-champions. There was no ASUN champion in 2021.

UCA also won the 2019 Southland Conference championship, the last year it was contested before the pandemic in 2020.

JUST FOR KICKS:

One of the most prolific placekickers in UCA history **Hayden Ray** finished his career last season as the Bears' all-time leader in field goals (44) and extra points (174). He also had the top PAT percentage in school history at 98.8% (174 of 176).

Ray, from Bryant, Ark., was named the ASUN Scholar-Athlete of the Year for football. He had a 4.0 grade-point average while earning his master's degree in health promotion.

WINNING WAYS:

UCA enters 2023 as the second winningest college football program in the state of Arkansas since 2000, and No. 1 among Division I schools.

UCA has recorded 40 winning seasons in the past 48 years, dating back to 1973. UCA tied the school record with 11 victories in 2005, and won 10 games in both 2016 and 2017.

WATCH LISTS:

UCA has three players on preseason Watch Lists heading into 2023.

Both defensive end David Walker and safety TaMuarion Wilson were named to the Buck Buchanan Award Watch List, while running back ShunDerrick Powell was on the Walter Payton Award Watch List.

Walker was one of three finalists for the Buchanan Award last year as a sophomore in his first season at UCA. Powell was a finalist for the Payton Award while at North Alabama last fall.

That award is named for the NFL Hall of Famer who played collegiately at Jackson State in the early 1980s and goes to the top FCS offensive player in the nation.

Past winners of the Payton Award include Steve McNair, Tony Romo, Jimmy Garrapalo, Cooper Cupp and Trey Lance. UCA competed against both Cupp (Eastern Washington) and Lance (North Dakota State).

CAREER NUMBERS:

Junior running back Darius Hale (Pearland, Texas) topped the 2,000-yard rushing mark in the season opener at Oklahoma State and now has 2,179 yards. He also has 33 career touchdowns (30 rushing, 3 receiving). The 30 rushing TDs puts him tied for 6th in school history with two seasons remaining.

Senior Christian Richmond has 2,361 career kickoff return yards, putting him third in school history behind Jatavious Wilson (2,905, 2013-16) and Isaiah Jackson (2,430, 2008-11).

Junior punter Chandler Caughron's 41.3-yard career average is second in school history behind Matt Spencer (42.23, 2014-15).

Senior DE Logan Jessup has 36.0 career tackles for loss, good for 9th on the all-time chart. His 21.0 sacks is 6th all-time.

For his career, covering both UCA and Northern Iowa, QB Will McElvain has 7,765 passing yards and 54 touchdowns.

Running back ShunDerrick Powell had a combined 1,662 rushing yards in his two seasons at North Alabama before transferring to UCA, and has 744 at UCA, for a career total of 2,409.

THE STRIPES:

The Bears will host six regular-season games this season at First Security Field at Estes Stadium, also known as "The Stripes". A brand new turf was installed in 2021, replacing the original Stripes installed in 2011.

The Bears are 48-14 since the arrival of the unique purple and gray stripes playing surface. UCA went a perfect 11-0 on "The Stripes" through the first two seasons on the turf (2011-12).

Over the past 16 seasons since moving to Division I, UCA's home record is 72-22, including 7-0 in 2008, 5-0 in 2011, 6-0 in 2012 and 3-0 in 2020.

PLAYERS OF THE WEEK:

Last season, the Bears had 12 players named ASUN Players of the Week.

They included: RB Darius Hale (Offensive Player of the Week twice); RB Kylin James (Off); WR Myles Butler (Fresh); PR Jarrod Barnes (SpT); S TaMuarion Wilson (Def.); TE Jordan Owens (Fresh); LB Demetrias Charles (Def.); QB Will McElvain (Off.); LB Corley Hooper (Def.), and DB Sean Smith (Def.).

UCA claimed three of the four weekly honors after a road win at Idaho State on Sept. 17.

NON-OFFENSIVE TDS:

UCA had six non-offensive touchdowns and one safety last season.

The Bears picked up a 3-yard scoop-and-score from Corley Hooper in the third game at Idaho State. At SEMO, T.D. Williams returned a fumble 85 yards for a touchdown.

In the Austin Peay game, Jarrod Barnes returned a punt 64 yards for a TD.

Against Lindenwood, UCA's Christian Richmond broke off a 100-yard kickoff return, tied for the second longest in school history. The record is 102 yards by Ewell Thompson in 1946 prior to the rule change. Richmond struck again against UNA with an 82-yard KO return for a TD.

Barnes then added a 67-yard punt return for a TD against SFA. UCA also recorded a first-quarter safety vs. UNA.

THE SIGNING CLASS:

UCA The University of Central Arkansas added 26 new football Bears on 2023 National Signing Day. The breakdown of new student-athletes is as follows: seven defensive backs; four wide receivers; four offensive linemen; three

linebackers; three running backs; two defensive linemen; one quarterback; one tight end and one placekicker.

The new student-athletes are from Arkansas (11), Mississippi (7), Texas (6), Florida (1) and Alabama (1).

QB GURUS:

UCA's coaching staff features two of the best quarterbacks to ever play at UCA in head coach Nathan Brown and offensive coordinator Ken Collums.

Brown set school and state records during his career (2004-08) in nearly every category, passing for 10,558 yards and 100 touchdowns.

Collums, who led the 1991 NAIA national championship team as a freshman, threw for 5,578 yards and 39 touchdowns during his career (1991-94) on teams more geared toward the running game.

Brown has been a part of the UCA coaching staff since graduation in 2009, while Collums has had three stints at UCA (counting graduate assistant), with a head coaching position at Abilene Christian sandwiched between them.

Both Brown (2016) and Collums (2018) are in the UCA Sports Hall of Fame.

PLENTY OF LOCALS:

UCA has 45 football players listed on its roster from the state of Arkansas. The next closest state is Texas with 23 players, followed by Mississippi with 19. UCA only has two players from the state of Oklahoma, redshirt freshman linebacker Duncan Parham (Norman) and freshman defensive back Griffin Dyer (Tulsa).

The Bears' two-deep for the season opener lists 23 starters or backups from within the state of Arkansas.

2022 ALL-ASUN TEAM:

UCA had a league-high eight players named to the 2022 All-ASUN Conference Football Team, along with the Defensive Player of the Year and the Freshman of the Year awards.

Sophomore defensive end David Walker was named the Defensive Player of the Year, while freshman offensive lineman Will Diggins is the 2022 Freshman of the Year.

The All-ASUN selections included: Walker, defensive end Logan Jessup, safety Cameron Godfrey, safety TaMuarion Wilson, running back Darius Hale, wide receiver Jarrod Barnes, offensive lineman Jaylin Hendrix and punter Chandler Caughron.

BEAR TRACKS...

- Will McElvain's 31 completions against SEMO was the most since Breylin Smith had 30 against Eastern Kentucky on 10/24/20.
- In the past two weeks (vs. SUU/SEMO), Will McElvain has completed 60 of 92 passes (65.2%) for 746 yards, with 7 touchdowns and 2 interceptions (373 yards per game).
- The 14 penalties (147 yards) against Southern Utah was the most since the Bears had 10 (81 yards) against Lindenwood on 10/8/22.
- UCA's 16 rushing yards at SEMO last year was the lowest since they had 39 vs. Incarnate Word on 11/10/18. This year they had 100 yards.
- The last UCA running back to have 200+ rushing yards prior to ShunDerrick Powell's 218 at NDSU was Darius Hale against UNA last season (258).
- UCA played just its third indoor game in school history at NDSU. The Bears also played NDSU at the Fargodome in 2020 and at Idaho State's Holt Arena last season.
- UCA's Chandler Caughron did not punt at all vs. Texas College. The last time the Bears did not punt in a game was Sept. 27, 2014 in a 52-18 win over Nicholls State in Conway. UCA's punter that season was career average leader Matt Spencer.
- Prior to last season, UCA had won 23 consecutive home openers at Estes Stadium, dating back to a 1999 loss to perennial D-II power North Alabama. Missouri State beat UCA 27-14 last year in the home opener.
- UCA's 27-13 loss at Oklahoma State was the second-closest to a Power 5 opponent, trailing only a 42-35 at Texas Tech in 2014.
- Jake Gaster's 9 PATs vs. Texas College was the most since Hayden Ray had 8 vs. UNA last season. It is also tied for the most in school history for a single game. Ray had 9 in a win over Texas Wesleyan in 2021.
- The last time UCA played an NAIA team, prior to Texas College, was in 2021 when it beat Texas Wesleyan 63-3 at Estes Stadium.
- RB ShunDerrick Powell's only appearance on "The Stripes" was last season while playing for North Alabama. He put on a show with 159 yards rushing and two touchdowns against the Bears before transferring to UCA in the offseason
- RB Darius Hale has had two 250+ rushing games in the past two seasons. He had 255 yards vs. North Alabama last season, and had 253 vs. Lamar the previous season.
- Hale became UCA's 16th 2,000-yard rusher against Oklahoma State.
- ShunDerrick Powell had four games where he topped the 200-yard rushing mark last season at UNA, including a career-high 251 vs. UVA-Wise, and has two more this season.
- In a six-game stretch last season (beginning with Idaho State through North Alabama), QB Will McElvain threw for 1,714 yards (285 avg.) with 14 touchdowns and 2 interception and completed 117 of 174 passes (67.2%).
- UCA scored 49, 49, 51 and 64 points in a four-game span (53.2 avg) from APSU to UNA last season.
- UCA converted 85% of its red-zone chances last season (34 of 40), including 60 percent touchdowns (24 of 40).
- The Bears were a perfect 45 of 45 on PATs in 2022, all by senior Hayden Ray.
- Then sophomore RB Kylin James completed 2 of 2 passes last year, both for touchdowns. He hit Jarrod Barnes with an 80-yard strike against SEMO and Barnes again for a 49-yard TD against Kennesaw State. He connected with Tyler Hudson on a 42-yard TD pass at Lamar in 2021.

James is now 3 for 3 with three touchdowns for his career. He was UCA's second-leading rusher (649 yards) and tied for leading receiver ((40-581) last season.

- David Walker's 4.5 tackles for loss vs. UNA was the second most in UCA history. The record is held by Icsom Jones (5.0, 2003 vs. Ouachita Baptist). Both Walker (vs. Missouri State) and Logan Jessup (vs. APSU) had 4.0 earlier last season.
- RB Darius Hale has had six 100-yard rushing games in his two-year career at UCA, including two of more than 250 yards.
- UCA's 733 yards of total offense against UNA last season was the most since 664 vs. Texas Wesleyan in 2001.
- UCA's 456 rushing yards against UNA was the most since they had 472 vs. Texas Wesleyan in 2021.
- Darius Hale's 255 rushing yards was the most since his own 253-yard performance against Lamar last season.
- Kennesaw had won 13 straight home games last season before the UCA loss, and had out-rushed 16 consecutive opponents. UCA won that battle 191-186.
- Will McElvain's five TD passes vs. Lindenwood was the most since Breylin Smith had five vs. Texas Wesleyan in 2021.
- Jarrod Barnes' punt return for a touchdown vs. Austin Peay was UCA's first since Tremon Smith (now with the Houston Texans) had a 47-yarder at Arkansas State (9/24/16).
- T.D. Williams' 85-yard fumble return for a touchdown against SEMO was UCA's second in two weeks. LB Corley Hooper returned one 3 yards for a score at Idaho State on 9/17.
- Will McElvain's 82.7 percent completion rate against Idaho State (24 of 29) was the 9th best in school history. Ironically, his head coach Nathan Brown has four of the top 8 performances. Zak Clark is first at 100% (11 of 11) vs. Iowa Wesleyan in 2004. Andy Rogers is 2nd (14 of 15, 93.3%) vs. Henderson State in 2001.
- Jarrod Barnes' 67-yard punt return for a TD against SFA was UCA's first since Barnes also had a 64-yarder vs. Austin Peay (10/1/22)

HC NATHAN BROWN:

UCA head coach Nathan Brown will be entering his sixth season as head coach and his 13th season overall on the UCA coaching staff. The former record-setting UCA quarterback served as offensive coordinator and quarterbacks coach from 2014-17 under Steve Campbell. Brown, from nearby Russellville, Ark., threw for 10,558 yards and 100 touchdowns during his record-setting career at UCA (2005-09).

REMEMBERING MILISA MOORE:

The Bears will wear special pink decals on their helmets this season in honor of the late Milisa Moore, long-time administrative assistant in the athletic department. She passed away in May after a lengthy battle with breast cancer.

Her son-in-law is Alex Fotioo, is UCA's director of strength and conditioning.

AFFILIATIONS:

The timeline for the Bears ascension to NCAA Division I FCS began at the NAIA level. UCA competed in the NAIA until 1993 when it left the Arkansas Intercollegiate Conference and moved to NCAA Division II and into the Gulf South Conference.

UCA remained there until 2006-07 when it made the move to D-I and into the Southland Conference in July 2006. The Bears spent 15 years in the SLC before making the move to the ASUN in on July 1, 2021.

UCA finished its run in the SLC with an impressive 73-29-0 conference record, a .716 winning percentage. That includes an 9-0 record in 2017, 8-1 mark in 2016, 6-1 records in 2008, 2011 and 2012 and a 7-2 mark in 2015 and 2019.

FCS PLAYOFF HISTORY:

UCA has made five appearances in the NCAA Division I FCS Playoffs since moving up in 2006-07. UCA beat Tennessee Tech in the first round in 2011 (34-14 in Cookeville, Tenn.), then lost to Montana 41-14 in Missoula.

In 2012, the Bears lost their opening game at Georgia Southern 24-16 in Statesboro, Ga. UCA hosted Illinois State in 2016 in the first round and won 31-24 before losing 31-14 at Eastern Washington in Cheney, Wash.

UCA was also nationally seeded in 2017 and hosted New Hampshire in the second round but lost 21-15. In 2019, UCA earned a No. 8 national seed and drew a bye before losing 24-14 to Illinois State in the second round on "The Stripes" in Conway.

SCORING STREAK:

The Bears had a streak of 274 games in which they scored broken with the shutout loss to Southeastern Louisiana on Nov. 9, 2019. The last shutout overall prior to that was when UCA lost 19-0 at Delta State in 1995. The last shutout at home prior to that was 1986 against East Central Oklahoma in the NAIA days.

The Bears have now scored in 420 of their last 421 games since 1986.

FAMOUS ALUMS:

UCA's most famous football alumnus is Monte Coleman, who played 16 seasons (1979-94) with the Washington Redskins and won three Super Bowl titles. Coleman, from Pine Bluff, Ark., was a linebacker and safety at UCA from 1975-78 and is the former head football coach at Arkansas-Pine Bluff.

UCA's most famous non-football alum is Scottie Pippen, a six-time NBA champion and two-time Olympic Dream Teamer. Pippen grew up in tiny Hamburg, Ark. in the SE Arkansas delta region and played at UCA from 1983-87 as a walk-on before becoming a two-time first-team NAIA All-American and then going 5th in the 1987 NBA Draft.

The court at the Farris Center was named for Pippen in the summer of 2021, with his signature added to midcourt.

HEAD COACH NATHAN BROWN



The most prolific quarterback in University of Central Arkansas history became the 20th head coach of the program in December 2017 when Nathan Brown was hired to replace Steve Campbell.

Brown, a 2016 inductee in the UCA Sports Hall of Fame in his first year of eligibility, spent the previous four years (2014-17) as the Bears' offensive coordinator on teams that went 33-15 (.688), including 20-5 (.800) in 2016-17 and had the most efficient passing offense in the FCS in 2017.

Brown, a native of Russellville, Ark., led the Bears to a 6-5 mark in his first season as head coach in 2018. Of the five losses by the Bears, two were by three or less points, including one in overtime. UCA finished 5-4 in Southland Conference play.

The Bears had the No. 4 scoring offense in the league, the No. 2 rushing defense and the No. 3 scoring defense.

In Year 2, the Bears finished 9-4 overall and went 7-2 in conference play (co-champions), earning a No. 8 national seeding in the FCS Playoffs and a bye in the first round before hosting Illinois State at First Security Field at Estes Stadium. The playoff appearance was the fifth overall and third in the previous four years.

UCA not only survived but thrived during the pandemic season of 2020, playing a full fall schedule when many programs sat out the season. UCA, which played the first college football game in the nation (FCS Kickoff Classic), finished 5-4 against one of the toughest schedules in school history, with a pair of FBS opponents and the eight-time FCS champion North Dakota State, all on the road.

The Bears came back with another tough schedule in 2021, playing FBS Arkansas State, along with a slate of games in the new ASUN/WAC Challenge in UCA's first year in the ASUN.

The Bears won a share of the first-ever ASUN championship in 2022, going 3-2 in league play. UCA also took on another formidable schedule, playing at #22 Ole Miss, at Idaho State and at Southeast Missouri, which won the Ohio Valley Conference title.

Since arriving on the UCA campus as a student-athlete in 2004, Brown has immersed himself in the football program here as not only a player, but as a coach. While playing at UCA, he was a record breaking starting quarterback and a 3-time All American player who was UCA's first player to participate in the prestigious Senior Bowl.

As a coach, Brown's offenses totaled 20,969 yards and averaged 437 yards per game during his years as offensive coordinator, while having three different quarterbacks being named first-team All-Southland Conference (Hayden Hildebrand 2017, Wynrick Smothers 2012, Nathan Dick 2011). Hildebrand was the SLC Player of the Year while Smothers was the SLC Offensive Player of the Year.

During his years as quarterbacks coach at UCA, the Bears' quarterbacks averaged 3,211 passing yards per season, eclipsing the 3,000-yard yard plateau six times, for a total of 25,691 yards. With Brown as the Bears' offensive coordinator, UCA had 17 All-SLC offensive first or second team selections, including a Freshman, Player and two Offensive Linemen of the Year selections. The Bears ranked in the Top 10 in FCS scoring three times in four years, and ranked seventh in the country in total offense in 2017.

Brown coached four of the top six total offense seasons in school history, and he was the starting quarterback for the other two seasons. He also played or coached in seven of the top 10 passing offensive seasons in program history. Brown has been a part of three Southland Conference Championships,



one as a player in 2008 and two as an assistant coach in 2012 and 2017.

Brown has been a part of all four of UCA's NCAA postseason playoff victories, two as a player (Division II) and two as a coach (FCS).

Equally as impressive as his coaching credentials are his numbers from his playing days at UCA. Brown was a three-time All-American who threw for 10,558 yards and 100 touchdowns in his career, both records for a collegiate quarterback in the state of Arkansas. The Bears went 30-10 with Brown as the starting quarterback.

He was the SLC Offensive Player of the Year in 2007 and the SLC Player of the Year in 2008, when he was also a Walter Payton Award finalist. Brown also owns school records for touchdown passes in a game (7) and most yards of total offense (490).

Before UCA moved to Division I in 2006, Brown was named the Gulf South Conference Freshman of the year in 2005.

Brown was UCA's first player to receive an invitation to the Senior Bowl All-Star game in the NCAA Division I era and was the leading passer in the 2009 game. He was also selected for the East-West Shrine Game that same year. He was a free-agent signee of both the Jacksonville Jaguars and New Orleans Saints.

Brown received his bachelor's degree in business education from the University of Central Arkansas in 2009 after graduating from Russellville High School in 2004.

He and his wife, Jessica (also a UCA graduate) have two children, daughter Rylee and son Luke.
